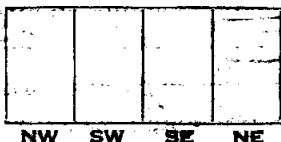
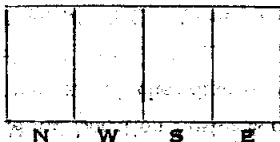

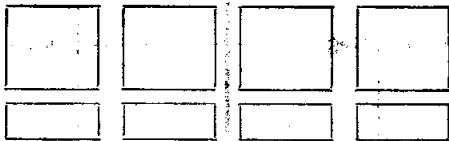
DIAGONAL POSITION
