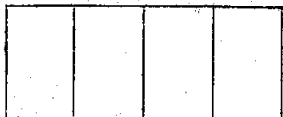
Quarter Corner common to Sections 6 and 5

Corner consists of a Wood post (not) in place State condition good

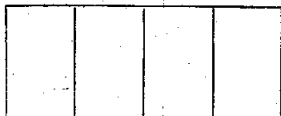

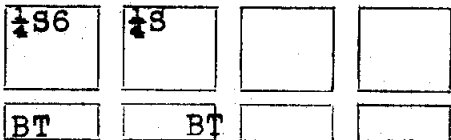

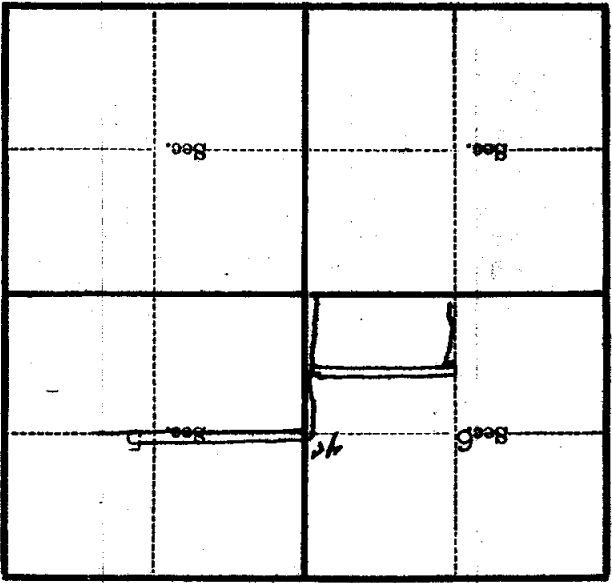
