Assessor *et cetera*. The Assessor shall add up and state the amount of each column in the assessment books; he shall also make in each book, under proper headings, a similar statement showing the footing of the several columns upon each page; and shall add up and set down, under the respective headings, the total amounts of the several columns, and so on at bottom the first Monday of July, he shall make returns to the County Auditor of his assessment books, and follow thereafter the law and accounts of all persons concerned, all of which shall be filed and preserved in the office of the County Auditor. Such returns shall be verified by the officers, respectively in the following form:
