
Notice to Assessors.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO ASSESSORS.

I would respectfully call the attention of Assessors to the following portion of the laws of 1878, Section 41:


Assessors must add up and note the aggregate of each column of their assessment books, both real and personal, and give the same by adding up and down and traverse the sheet. They shall also make, under proper headings, a tabular statement showing the footings of the several columns upon each page. Assessors are especially requested to return their books to this office as or before the first Monday in July. It is absolutely necessary for the Auditor to have them as early as possible, in order to prepare them for the Board of Equalization.
