Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. \* \* \* Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list the real property owned by him, and the equity of his interest therein, and all moneys and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property; where listed. All household goods and furniture, including books, musical instruments, and all personal property used by the family for domestic purposes, or for the furnishing or equipment of the family dwelling, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.29. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property pertaining to the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer shall be listed in the town or district where his business is carried on. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of livestock or other personal property connected with a farm does not reside therein, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the same is usually kept, or in the town or district in which the principal place of business of such farm is located.

Sec. 273.32. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and warehouses, with the machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon the land of any railroad company which are not in good faith owned, leased, or used by such company, shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.33. Pipeline Companies. Subdivision 1. Personal property pertaining to the business of a pipeline company shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept. Subdivision 2. The personal property, consisting of the pipeline system of mains, pipes and equipment attached thereto, of pipeline companies, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.36. Electric Light and Power Companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies, and other companies, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.37. Electric Light and Power Companies and others supplying electric power; place of listing and assessment. Personal property of electric light and power companies, and other companies, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.39. Merchants; Conditions. Every merchant shall list his property and state the value of his property pertaining to his business as a merchant. No consignee shall be required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, nor the value of any such property, and derive no profit from its sale.

Sec. 273.34. Manufacturers. Every manufacturer required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, shall, in addition to the value of any such property, and derive no profit from its sale, or in part in any process of manufacturing, combining, specifying, or otherwise held for the purpose of being used in the manufacture of any kind of article, or in the process of manufacturing stock, the value of all engines, machinery, tools, and implements as have been considered real property.

Sec. 273.43. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, shall, in addition to the value of any such property, and derive no profit from its sale, or in part in any process of manufacturing, combining, specifying, or otherwise held for the purpose of being used in the manufacture of any kind of article, or in the process of manufacturing stock, the value of all engines, machinery, tools, and implements as have been considered real property.

Sec. 273.44. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing of the decedent. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing of the decedent.

Sec. 273.45. Persons under Guardianship. The personal property of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing of the minor.

Sec. 273.46. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing of the assignor or grantor.

Sec. 273.47. Property moved between May and July. The assessor of personal property remaining from one county, town, or district, shall list the property as if it were in the county, town, or district in which it is first called upon by the assessor.

Sec. 273.48. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, shall, in addition to the value of any such property, and derive no profit from its sale, or in part in any process of manufacturing, combining, specifying, or otherwise held for the purpose of being used in the manufacture of any kind of article, or in the process of manufacturing stock, the value of all engines, machinery, tools, and implements as have been considered real property.

Sec. 273.49. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, shall, in addition to the value of any such property, and derive no profit from its sale, or in part in any process of manufacturing, combining, specifying, or otherwise held for the purpose of being used in the manufacture of any kind of article, or in the process of manufacturing stock, the value of all engines, machinery, tools, and implements as have been considered real property.

Sec. 273.50. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, shall, in addition to the value of any such property, and derive no profit from its sale, or in part in any process of manufacturing, combining, specifying, or otherwise held for the purpose of being used in the manufacture of any kind of article, or in the process of manufacturing stock, the value of all engines, machinery, tools, and implements as have been considered real property.
