To According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Real and Personal Property Assessment Books for the year 1950, containing a list of all Real Estate subject to taxation, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess all Property and make return thereof to me as required by the laws of the State of Minnesota prescribing the duties of the assessor.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAX. TAXATION: All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, *** is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. * * * Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. All gas and steam engines, and all other machinery, shall be listed by the owner or his agent, or by the principal or agent of the person owning the same.

Sec. 273.23. Gas and Water Companies. The personal property of gas and water companies shall be listed and assessed by the principal or agent of the company in the town or district where the principal or agent of the company is located.

Sec. 273.24. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a minor and of a guardian of the estate of a minor shall be listed by the guardian of the estate of every other person under guardianship, where the ward resides.

Sec. 273.45. Persons under Guardianship. The personal property of a minor and of a guardian of the estate of a minor shall be listed by the guardian of the estate of every other person under guardianship, where the ward resides.

Sec. 273.46. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the time of listing at the time of the listing.

Sec. 273.47. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list his personal property shall verify the list by a sworn statement under oath in his own handwriting, which shall be filed with the assessor.

Sec. 273.48. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the proper place of listing personal property or where it cannot be listed as in this chapter provided, it between places in the same county, the assessor shall determine the proper place by the county board of equalization, and if between different counties, or places in different counties, by the Commissioner of Taxation.

Sec. 273.49. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list his personal property shall verify the list by a sworn statement under oath in his own handwriting, which shall be filed with the assessor.

Sec. 273.50. Assessor may enter dwellings, etc. Any officer authorized by law to make a return of personal property may, at the request of the assessor, enter any dwelling, house, building, or structure, and view the same and the property therein.

Sec. 273.51. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. How classified for purposes of taxation as provided by this section. Subdivision 2. Class 1. All agricultural products, except as provided by this section, shall be valued and assessed at 25 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Sec. 273.52. Merchants; Consignees. Every merchant required to list his property shall state also the value of his property required under this chapter.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.03. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property.

The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor and board of review member attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$6.00 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meetings, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county-seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.
