Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941 as Amended by Laws 1943)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all accessories thereto, are subject to taxation, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

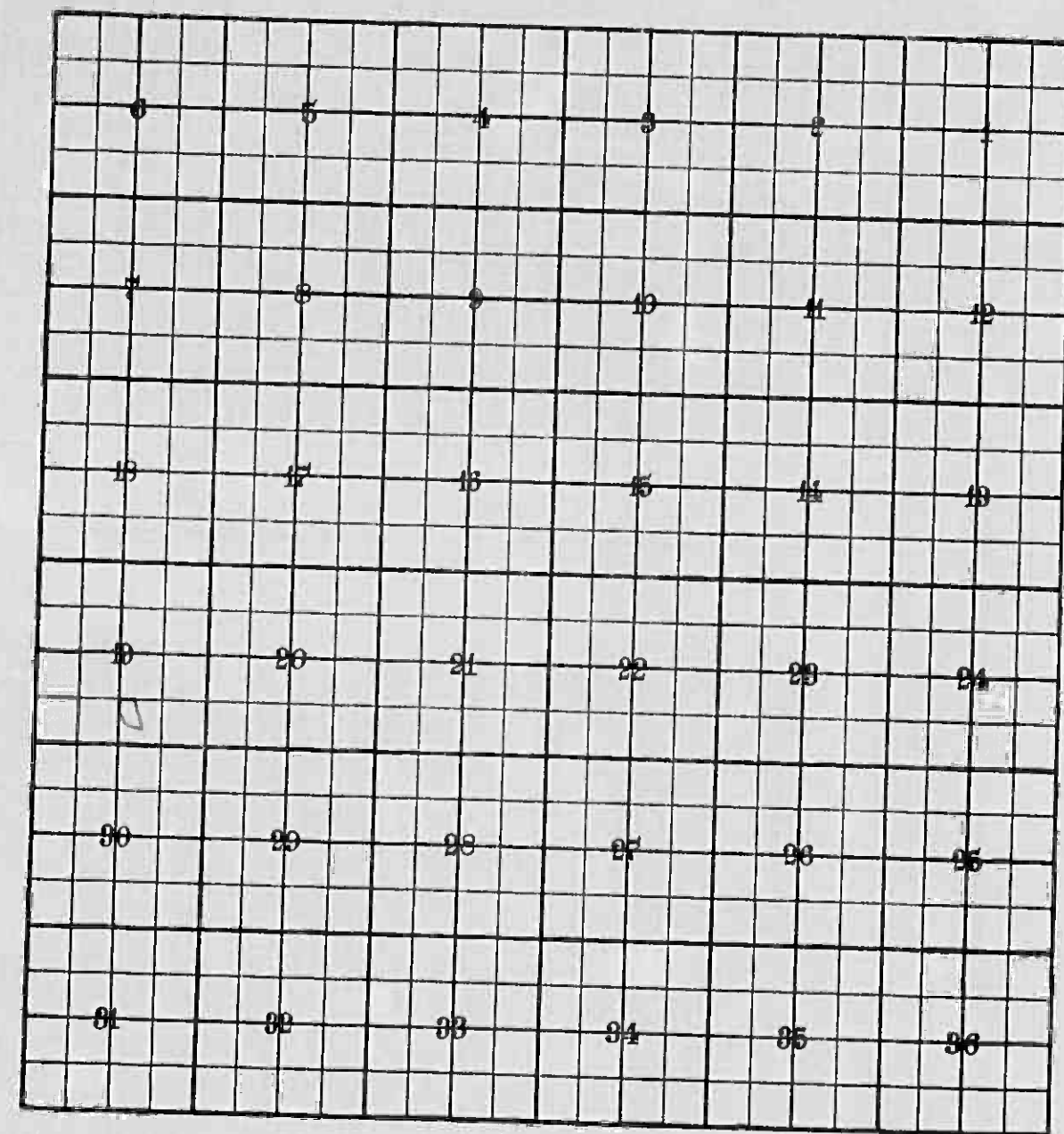
Sec. 273.03. Minnesota Statutes 1941. Assessment; Mode. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all taxable property subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number, location, and acreage of the tract or lot, and the value of the property. The list of real property becoming subject to assessment and taxation, and the list of personal property assessment books, shall be in readiness for delivery to the assessors on or before the first Monday in April of each year. The assessors shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions and their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such services the sum of five cents per mile for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meetings, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.
