Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, is taxable, except as provided by law.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal Property shall be listed annually on May 1, and assessed on that day, on the value thereof as shown on that day, and the assessment shall be final.

Sec. 273.01. Personal Property shall be listed annually on May 1, and assessed on that day, on the value thereof as shown on that day, and the assessment shall be final. Sec. 273.02. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list...

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.03 as amended. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county for and to correspond with each assessment district.
