

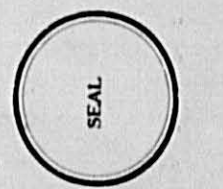

EXTRACTS FROM LAWS

(Section Numbers refer to Mason's Minn. Statutes 1927.)
Sec. 1974. Property subject to taxation—All real and personal property in the state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

Sec. 1984. All real property subject to taxation shall be assessed every even-numbered year with reference to its value on May 1 preceding the assessment, and all personal property subject to taxation shall be assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it.

Sec. 1989. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind who is the owner, possessor, or administrator of any real or personal property in this state, shall list the same on May 1, and all taxes thereon shall be paid into the district where the property is situated on that day.

Sec. 1992. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed at the place where the same is kept, used, or stored, or for the furnishing or repair of the same, or for the carrying on of any business, or for the operation of any machinery or fixtures therein, situated upon the land owned by the person liable to list the same, and, if not known, at the principal place of business of such person.

Sec. 2003. Merchants and manufacturers. Personal property shall be listed and assessed at the place where the same is kept, used, or stored, or for the furnishing or repair of the same, or for the carrying on of any business, or for the operation of any machinery or fixtures therein, situated upon the land owned by the person liable to list the same, and, if not known, at the principal place of business of such person.

Sec. 2005. Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed at the place where the same is kept, used, or stored, or for the furnishing or repair of the same, or for the carrying on of any business, or for the operation of any machinery or fixtures therein, situated upon the land owned by the person liable to list the same, and, if not known, at the principal place of business of such person.

Sec. 2012-1. Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed at the place where the same is kept, used, or stored, or for the furnishing or repair of the same, or for the carrying on of any business, or for the operation of any machinery or fixtures therein, situated upon the land owned by the person liable to list the same, and, if not known, at the principal place of business of such person.

Sec. 2014. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the place where the same is kept, used, or stored, or for the furnishing or repair of the same, or for the carrying on of any business, or for the operation of any machinery or fixtures therein, situated upon the land owned by the person liable to list the same, and, if not known, at the principal place of business of such person.

Sec. 1997. Assessor may assess a copy of the statement showing the valuation of the property for taxation in the hands of the owner, receiver or assignee of the property, or of any other person, company, or corporation, whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property for taxation has not properly performed his duties, either as to the valuation of the property or as to the manner of listing the same.

Sec. 2006. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who makes or causes to be made a false statement regarding taxes, or who makes or causes to be made a statement which is false in any material matter which he knows to be false, or who makes or causes to be made a statement which is false in any material matter which he knows to be false, or who makes or causes to be made a statement which is false in any material matter which he knows to be false, shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
