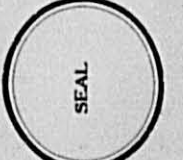

EXTRACTS FROM LAWS

(Section Numbers refer to Mason's Minn. Statutes 1927.)  
Sec. 1974. Property subject to taxation--All real and personal property in the state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt therefrom.  
Sec. 1984. All real property subject to taxation shall be listed and assessed every even-numbered year with reference to its value on May 1 preceding the assessment, and all real property becoming taxable any intervening year shall be listed and assessed with reference to its value on that day, and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if the value of that day is greater than the value of the preceding year, shall be listed and assessed at that value.  
Sec. 1989. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:  
1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all moneys, credits, bonds, shares of stock of joint stock or other companies or corporations (when the property of such company or corporation is not assessed in this state), household furniture, annuities, franchises, royalties, and other personal property.  
2. He shall list the property of any other person, company, or corporation, or of any other person, company, or corporation, and all moneys deposited subject to his order, check, or draft, and credits due from or owing to any person, company, or corporation.  
3. The property of a minor child or insane person shall be listed by the guardian, or by the person having such property in charge.  
4. The property of a person for whose benefit it is held in trust, by the trustee; of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.  
5. The property of a corporation whose assets are in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver.  
6. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or officer thereof.  
7. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.  
8. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent in the name of his principal, as merchant-tailor.  
Sec. 2002. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the owner, agent, or trustee resides.  
Sec. 2005. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property pertaining to the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer shall be listed in the town or district where his business is carried on: Provided, that logs and timber cut from lands within, and designed to be used in the business, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district in which they are located, and such taxes shall be a lien upon such logs and timber, which shall not be removed beyond the borders of this state until all such taxes are paid in full.  
Sec. 2008. Household Goods. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other personal property, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same is usually kept.  
Sec. 2010. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and warehouses, with the machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon the land of any railroad company which are not in good faith owned, operated and exclusively controlled by such company, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where situated, in the name of the owner, if known, and, if not known, as "owner unknown."  
Sec. 2012. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages, or of electric light and power companies outside of cities and villages. Personal property of electric light and power companies having a fixed situs outside the corporate limits of villages, cities and boroughs shall be listed with and assessed by the Minnesota tax commission in the county where situated.  
Sec. 2015. Persons under guardianship. The personal property of the estate of a deceased person shall be listed and assessed at the place of guardian residence; and of every other person under guardianship, in the hands of the ward or receiver, where the same is usually kept.  
Sec. 2016. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment.  
Sec. 2017. Lists to be verified. The assessor of personal property, commencing from one county, town, or district to another, between May 1 and July 1, shall be assessed in either in which he was first called upon, by the assessor of such county, town, or district, or by another from another state between said dates shall list the property owned by him on May 1 of such year in the county, town, or district in which he resides, unless he shall make it appear to the assessor that he is held for tax of the current year on the property in another state.  
Sec. 2018. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the proper place for listing personal property or where it cannot be listed as in this chapter provided, if between places in the same county, the place for listing and assessing shall be determined by the separate statements in like manner of all personal property owned by him on May 1 of the current year. He shall also make a statement in like manner of the personal property owned by him on May 1 of the current year, and such taxes shall be a lien upon such property until all such taxes are paid in full.  
Sec. 2022. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list property for taxation shall make out and deliver to the assessor upon blanks furnished by him, a verified statement of all personal property owned by him on May 1 of the current year. He shall also make a statement in like manner of the personal property owned by him on May 1 of the current year, and such taxes shall be a lien upon such property until all such taxes are paid in full.  
Sec. 2023. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property for himself, or for another, is not a resident of this state, or that the property listed is not his, or that the person listing is not the owner thereof, or that the person listing is not the owner thereof, he shall examine the person listing under oath, and deliver to the assessor a copy of the statement showing the valuation of the property so listed.  
Sec. 1997. Assessor may enter dwelling, etc. Any officer authorized by law to assess property for taxation may, when necessary to the proper performance of his duties, enter any dwelling house, building, or structure, and view the same and the property therein.  
Sec. 1998. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, in making any statement, oral or written, which is required or authorized by law to be made for the purpose of assessing property for taxation, or in making any statement, oral or written, which is required or authorized by law to be made for the purpose of assessing property for taxation, shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.  
Sec. 1999. Classification of Property. What percentages of full and true value to be assessed. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax and not subject to any gross earnings or other lien tax is hereby classified for purposes of taxation as follows:  
Class 1. From ore whether mined or unmined, shall constitute class one (1) and shall be valued and assessed at fifty (50) per cent of its full and true value.  
Class 2. From ore whether mined or unmined, shall constitute class two (2) and shall be valued and assessed at twenty-five (25) per cent of its full and true value.  
Class 3. Live stock, poultry, all agricultural products except as provided by class three "a," (3a), stocks of merchandise of all kinds, together with the materials and fixtures used therein, manufactured articles, all tools, implements, machinery, and other articles, shall constitute class three (3) and shall be valued and assessed at thirty-three and one-third (33 1/3) per cent of the true and full value thereof.  
Class 4. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer and not held for sale, and all agricultural tools, implements and machinery, shall constitute class four (4) and shall be valued and assessed at ten (10) per cent of the full and true value thereof.  
Class 5. All property not included in the three preceding classes shall constitute class five (5) and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.
