Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Mason's Minnesota Statutes, 1927.)

Sec. 1974. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All Real and Personal Property in this State, and all Personal Property of corporations, shall be assessed, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED.

Sec. 1984. ... Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it.

Sec. 1989. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this State, shall list his money, credits, bonds, shares of property, and all other personal property owned by him, and the property of such company or corporation in not assessed in this State, and other personal property.

Sec. 2003. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the town, or district where the owner, agent, or trustee resides.

Sec. 2005. Exemptions, etc. on railroad. All engines and cars, and all machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon the railroad, and all other personal property owned by the railroad, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the railroad is located.

Sec. 2006. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of a farm or other personal property is a non-resident, the property shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the farm is situated.

Sec. 2008. Electric light and power. All electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the principal office of the company is located.

Sec. 2010. Assessment and receiver. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing, before the appointment.

Sec. 2017. Property moved between May and July. The owner of personal property, removed from one county, town, or district in this State, to another county, town, or district, shall list the same in the county, town, or district to which it is removed, and the assessor of the county, town, or district to which it is removed, shall list the same in that county, town, or district.

Sec. 2022. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the county, town, or district in which personal property shall be listed, the assessor of the county, town, or district in which the property is located, shall determine the county, town, or district in which the property shall be listed.

Sec. 2023. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of the property to be assessed, and shall list the same in the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Sec. 2024. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property or himself has made a false statement, he may examine the person under oath in regard to the amount of the property to be assessed, and shall list the same in the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Sec. 2025. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of the property to be assessed, and shall list the same in the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Sec. 2026. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of the property to be assessed, and shall list the same in the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Sec. 2027. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of the property to be assessed, and shall list the same in the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Sec. 2028. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of the property to be assessed, and shall list the same in the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Sec. 2029. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of the property to be assessed, and shall list the same in the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

CHAPTER 86

Section 1. That Extra Section Laws 1927 1928, Class 2b and Class 2c, as amended by Laws 1929, Chapter 250, be amended so as to read as follows:

Class 2b. All unplatted real estate, except as provided by class 2c, shall be assessed at the true and full value thereof. Provided, that the true and full value shall be determined by the assessor of the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Class 2c. All unplatted real estate, except as provided by class 2b, shall be assessed at the true and full value thereof. Provided, that the true and full value shall be determined by the assessor of the county, town, or district in which the property is located.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after January 1, 1927.

Approved July 23, 1927.

Section 1956. Mason's Minnesota Statutes, 1927. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books, and every assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and in each description of property. The list of real property becoming subject to assessment and taxation every odd numbered year may be appended to the personal property assessment book. The assessment books and blanks shall be in readiness for delivery to the assessors on or before the third Monday in APRIL, of each year.
