Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:

- 1. Every item of real estate and every item of personal property owned by a person shall be listed by such person.
2. If the property is owned by a partnership, it shall be listed by one of the partners.
3. If the property is owned by a corporation, it shall be listed by one of its officers.
4. If the property is owned by a trust, it shall be listed by the trustee.
5. If the property is owned by a partnership, it shall be listed by one of the partners.
6. If the property is owned by a corporation, it shall be listed by one of its officers.
7. If the property is owned by a trust, it shall be listed by the trustee.

Sec. 273.23. Merchants, consignees, and persons in possession of property. Every merchant and consignee shall list the property in his hands as if it were his own. Every person in possession of property shall list the property in his hands as if it were his own.

Sec. 273.24. Farm property. Farm property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.25. Certain personal property. Where listed, all personal property used by the owner for personal and domestic purposes shall be listed and assessed in the manner following:

- 1. The property of a firm or company, by the proper agent thereof.
2. The property of a partnership, by one of the partners.
3. The property of a corporation, by one of its officers.
4. The property of a trust, by the trustee.
5. The property of a partnership, by one of the partners.
6. The property of a corporation, by one of its officers.
7. The property of a trust, by the trustee.

Sec. 273.26. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who makes a false statement regarding taxes shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.

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Sec. 273.33. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who makes a false statement regarding taxes shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.

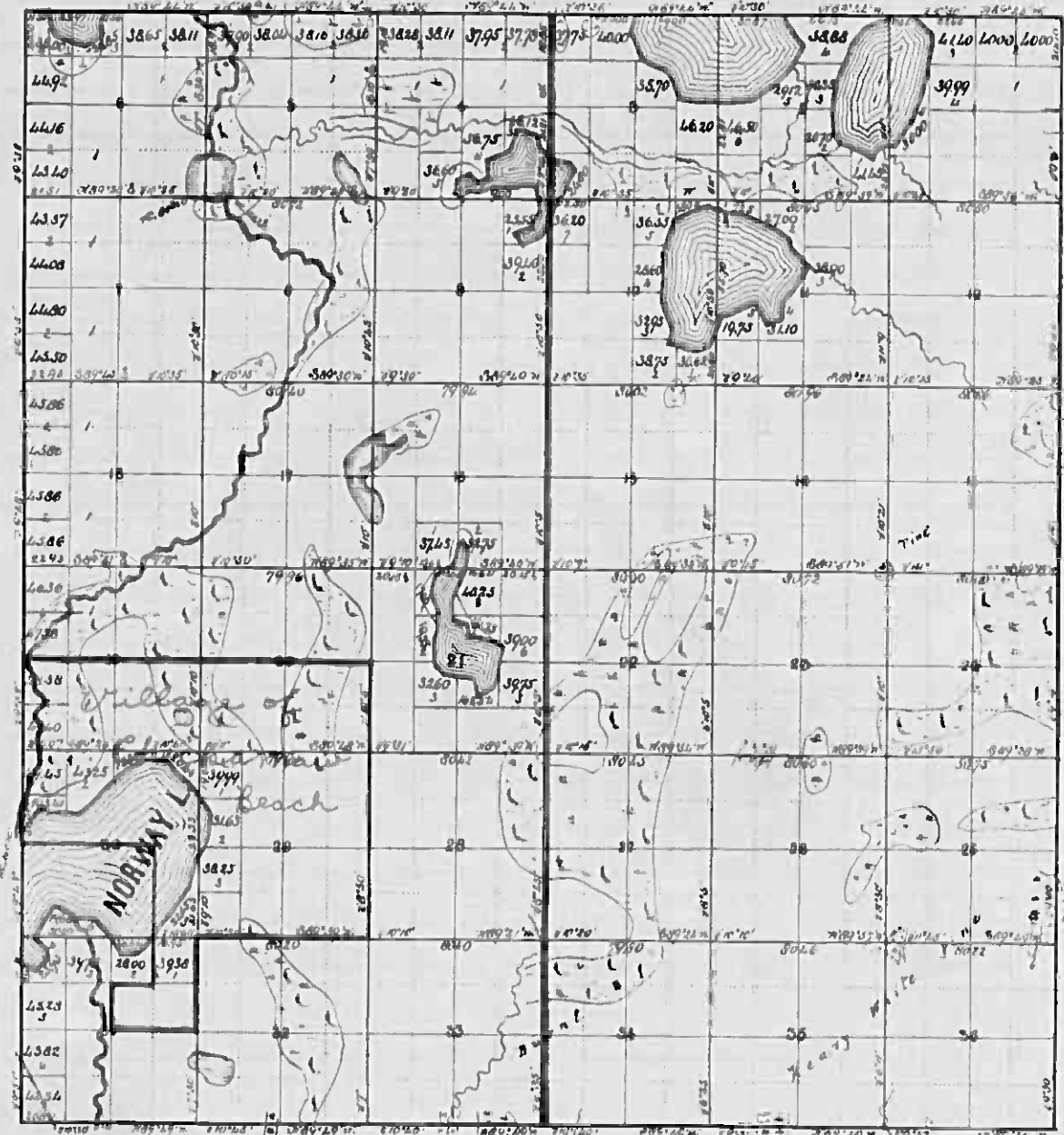
