Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property. (Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all property of persons residing therein, *** is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED. Sec. 273.01. * * * Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or agent.

2. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.

3. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by the property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent.

Sec. 273.26. Where listed. Except otherwise provided in this chapter, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where owned, leased, or otherwise situated.

Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property; where listed. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments and all personal property used by the owner for personal and domestic purposes, or for the furnishing or equipment of the family and household, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.29. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property pertaining to the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer *** listed in the town or district where his business is carried on ***.

Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of livestock or other personal property connected with a farm does not reside in this state, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.32. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and warehouses, with the machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon the land of any railroad company which are not in good faith owned, leased, or otherwise situated, shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.33. Pipeline Companies. Subdivision 1. Personal property of *** pipeline companies, including but not limited to the following: natural gas, gasoline, or other petroleum products *** shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Subdivision 2. The personal property, consisting of the pipeline system of mains, pipes and equipment attached thereto, of pipeline companies, including but not limited to the following: natural gas, gasoline, or other petroleum products *** shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.34. Electric Light and Power Companies, and others supplying electric power; place of listing and assessment of personal property with situs outside corporate boundaries. The personal property of electric light and power companies, including but not limited to the following: electric light and power companies, and others supplying electric power, shall be listed and assessed in the district where situated, without regard to where the principal or other place of business of such company is located.

Sec. 273.35. Gas and Water Companies. The personal property of gas and water companies, including but not limited to the following: gas and water companies, shall be listed and assessed in the district where situated, without regard to where the principal or other place of business of such company is located.

Sec. 273.36. Power Companies, and others supplying electric power; place of listing and assessment of personal property with situs outside corporate boundaries. The personal property of electric light and power companies, including but not limited to the following: electric light and power companies, and others supplying electric power, shall be listed and assessed in the district where situated, without regard to where the principal or other place of business of such company is located.

Sec. 273.37. Merchants; Consignees. Every merchant required to list his property shall state also the value of his property pertaining to the business of a merchant, as amended.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.03, as amended. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property.***

The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor and board of review member attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$6.00 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county-seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

Sec. 273.38. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the proper place of listing personal property or where it cannot be listed in any one place, it shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.39. Persons under Guardianship. The personal property of persons under guardianship shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the guardian resides and of every other person under guardianship, where the ward resides.

Sec. 273.40. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the assignor or grantor resided at the time of his death.

Sec. 273.41. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor is required to examine any person under oath, he shall do so in the proper place of listing and assessing the same, and shall be sworn to by the person examined.

Sec. 273.42. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, in making any statement, oral or written, which is required to be made by him in connection with the listing or assessing of any real or personal property, makes a false statement, or omits any material matter which he knows to be false, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 273.43. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. How classified. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax shall be classified as follows: Class 1. Real estate, except as hereinafter classified.
