John G. Norman, Assessor of the Town of Bungo, according to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Real and Personal Property Assessment Books for the year 1944, containing a list of all Platted and Unplatted Real Estate subject to taxation, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source and I hereby direct you to assess all property and make return thereof to me as required by the law prescribing your duties hereto annexed.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book. County Auditor.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941 as Amended by Laws 1943)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of the owner residing therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED. Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent in the name of his principal, or otherwise in this chapter.

Personal property of a non-resident, when the owner does not reside therein, the same shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the owner, agent or trustee resides. Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property shall be listed by the owner, or by the person in whose name it is held, or by the trustee of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator of the estate, or by the person in whose hands the property of a corporation whose assets are in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver.

Sec. 273.28. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property of a merchant or manufacturer, or of a mercantile or manufacturing concern, shall be listed in the town or district where the same is usually kept. Sec. 273.29. 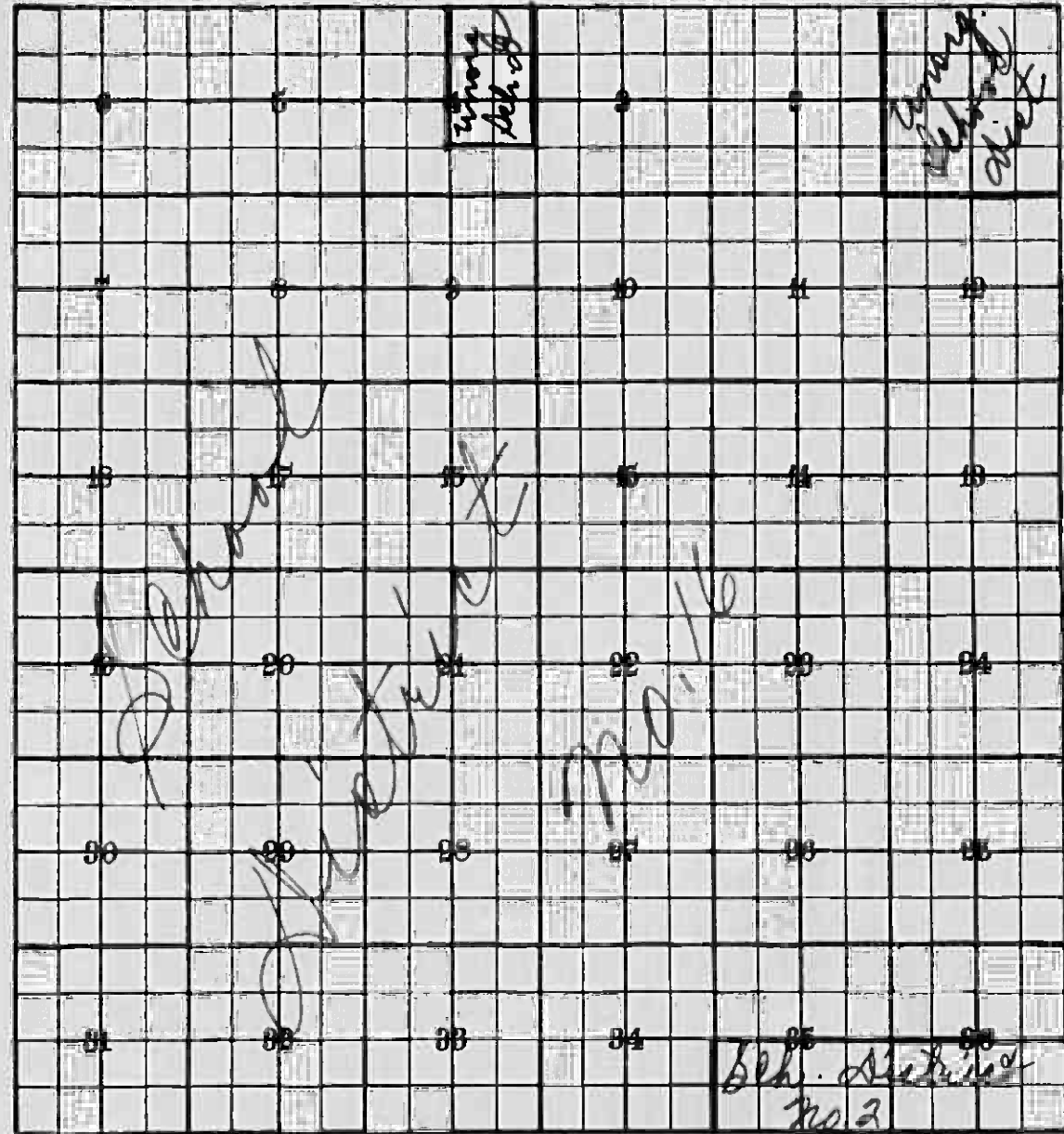
Sec. 272.03. Minnesota Statutes 1941. Assessment; Mode. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment year. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the number of lots or blocks, included in each description of property. The list of real property becoming subject to assessment shall be prepared by the county auditor, and shall be ready for the personal property assessment book on the first Monday of May next at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of the assessment. The assessment books and blanks shall be in readiness for delivery to the assessors on or before the first Monday of May next at their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive compensation for such service the sum of four dollars per day for each day necessarily traveled in going from his home to and from the county seat, the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and from the county seat, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor, computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.
