Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

Sec. 1974. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All Real and Personal Property in this State, and all Personal property of persons residing therein, . . . is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

Sec. 2002. Lists to be Verified. Every person required to list property for taxation shall make out and deliver to the assessor, on or before the first day of May of the current year, a list of all real and personal property owned by him on May 1 of the current year.

Section 1985. Mason's Minnesota Statutes, 1927. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, in the real property

Sec. 2014. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent, whether real or personal, shall be listed and assessed in the manner provided in this chapter, and the same shall be subject to taxation as if it were the property of the decedent.
