A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, *** is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:

- 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list and assess his personal property.
2. He shall also list and assess in the name of his principal, all money and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise conveyed by him as agent or attorney.
3. The property of a person shall be listed by his guardian, or by the person having such property in charge.
4. The property of a person for whose benefit it is held in trust, by a trustee, or of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator of the estate.
5. The property of a corporation whose assets are in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver.
6. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or officer.
7. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.
8. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an assignee, receiver, or trustee, by the assignee, receiver, or trustee.
9. The property of a partnership, as merchandise, provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where owner, agent or trustee resides.
10. The property of a partnership, as real estate, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the principal place of business of such firm is located.
11. The property of a partnership, as real estate, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the principal place of business of such firm is located.

Sec. 273.32. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and other machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon land and exclusively controlled by such company, shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.33. Pipeline Companies. Subdivision 1. Personal property of *** pipeline companies engaged in the business of transporting *** shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.
Subdivision 2. The personal property, consisting of the pipeline companies and others engaged in the operations of business of transporting *** shall be listed with and assessed by the owners by the lines, and shall be listed and assessed by the owners by the lines, and shall be listed with and assessed by the owners by the lines.

Sec. 273.36. Electric Light and Power Companies to be listed. The personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.37. Electric Light and Power Companies and other companies. The personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.38. Merchants; Consignees. Every merchant required to list his property shall state also the value of his property retained

ing to his business as a merchant. No consignor shall be required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, nor the value of any property consigned to him from any other place for the such property, and derive no profit from its sale.

Sec. 273.44. Manufacturers. Every manufacturer required to be listed shall also list and assess in the name of his principal, all money and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise conveyed by him as agent or attorney.

Sec. 273.45. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the time of his death.

Sec. 273.46. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the time of the assignment or receivership.

Sec. 273.47. Property moved between May and July. The personal property of a person shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.48. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the proper place of listing personal property or where it cannot be listed, the assessor shall list and assess the same in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.49. Lists to be filed. The assessor shall file a list of the personal property of each person assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.50. Assessor may enter dwellings, etc. Any officer authorized by law to assess property for taxation may, when necessary, enter any dwelling, building, or structure, and view the same and the property therein.

Sec. 273.51. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. Property shall be classified for purposes of taxation as provided by this section.

Subdivision 2. The personal property of a person shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Subdivision 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three, 'a', and class three, 'd', shall be valued and assessed at 33 1/3 per cent of their true and full value.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three, 'a', and class three, 'd', shall be valued and assessed at 33 1/3 per cent of their true and full value.

Subdivision 5. Class 3a. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class three, 'a', and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 6. Class 3d. Livestock, poultry, all horses, mules, and other animals, and machinery, tools, implements, and agricultural implements, shall constitute class three, 'd', and shall be valued and assessed at 33 1/3 per cent of their true and full value.

Subdivision 7. Class 3e. All property not included in any other class shall constitute class four and shall be valued and assessed at 40 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.03, as amended. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property.

The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor and board of review member attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$6.00 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county-seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

The forms in this book are prescribed for the 1950 assessment by G. HOWARD SPAETH, Commissioner of Taxation.

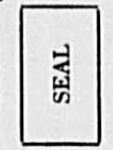
