Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941 as Amended by Laws 1943)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, *** is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. * * * Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.02. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his *** personal property...

Sec. 273.23. Pipeline companies. Personal property of *** pipeline companies engaged in the business of transporting and distributing gas, oil, steam, or other fluid, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.24. Manufacturers. Every manufacturer required to list his property shall also list the value of his stock, in whole or in part, in any process of manufacturing, combining, rectifying or refining...

Sec. 273.46. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment.

Sec. 273.47. Property moved between May and July. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district.

Sec. 273.21. Assessor may enter dwelling. Any officer authorized by law to be made as a basis of imposing or reducing taxes shall have the right to enter any dwelling, building, or structure, and view the same and the property therein, for the purpose of ascertaining the value thereof.

Sec. 273.22. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, in making any statement, oral or written, which is required or authorized by law to be made as a basis of imposing or reducing taxes, makes a false statement, or omits to state any material fact, shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

Sec. 273.23. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. How classified for purposes of taxation as provided by this section. Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined...

Subdivision 2. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other personal property actually used by the owner in any agricultural or domestic purposes...

Subdivision 3. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided in subdivision 4. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding subdivisions and assessed at 3 1/2 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 4. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding subdivisions and assessed at 3 1/2 per cent of the true and full value thereof. Class 5. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class three 'a'...

Subdivision 5. Class 5. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class three 'a' and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 6. Class 6. Livestock, poultry, all horses, mules, and asses used exclusively for agricultural purposes, all agricultural implements, and machinery used by the owner in any agricultural or domestic purposes...

Subdivision 7. Motor Vehicles which have been *** frozen *** by the Federal Government *** shall be assessed and valued at 5 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

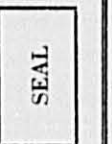
