According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the containing a list of all Real Estate that has become subject to taxation since the Assessment Books for the for the year 1955, as the same has come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess such Real Estate and all Personal Property, and make such changes in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof as required by the laws of the State of Minnesota prescribing the duties of the assessor.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property. (Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1953)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property, other than exempt property, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED. Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:

- 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this county, shall list the real property owned by him in his county, and in the case of a decedent, his estate, and all personal property owned by him at the time of his death. He shall also list separately and in the case of a decedent, his estate, all moneys and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney, ...

Sec. 273.23. Certain personal property; where listed. Sec. 273.24. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the time of his death.

Sec. 273.25. Persons under guardianship. The personal property of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed at the time of the ward's death and of every other person under guardianship.

Sec. 273.46. Assignments and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the time of such assignment or receivership.

Sec. 273.47. Personal property removed from one county, town, or district to another. Property moved between May and July, the assessor of personal property removing from one county, town, or district into this state from another state between said dates shall list the property owned by him on May 1 of such year in the county, town, or district to which he is first called upon to list.

Sec. 273.48. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain list of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of the personal property as best he can, and the amount as he believes to be the true value thereof. When requested, he shall sign and deliver to the person assessed a copy of the statement of personal property so assessed.

Sec. 273.49. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property for himself, for any other person, company, or corporation, has not made a full and true statement of his personal property, he may require the full oath in regard to the amount of the property to be required to be sworn to by the person assessed.

Sec. 520.05. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who shall be assessed for taxes on real or personal property, or who is authorized by law to make a return of such property for taxation, or who shall be assessed, who shall willfully make any statement as to the value of any kind of property for taxation, which he knows to be false, shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

Sec. 273.13. Classification of property-Subdivision 1. How classified. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax shall be classified for purposes of taxation as follows: ...

Subdivision 2. Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined shall constitute class one and shall be valued and assessed at fifty per cent of its true and full value.

Class 1a. All direct products of the blast and open hearth furnaces, whether or not further processed, shall constitute class 1a and shall be valued and assessed at 15 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 3. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and all other articles of personal and domestic purposes, used by the owner for personal and domestic purposes, or for the cleaning or maintenance of the property, shall constitute class two and shall be valued and assessed at 25 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a," and class three "d," stocks of merchandise, including grain, hay, and other crops, shall constitute class three, and shall be valued and assessed at 75 per cent of the full and true value thereof. ...

Subdivision 5. Class 3a. All agricultural products, including livestock, shall constitute class 3a and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 6. Class 3b. Livestock, poultry, all horses, mules, dogs, and all other animals, shall constitute class 3b and shall be valued and assessed at 20 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 9. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class four and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Sec. 273.23. Personal property removed from one county, town, or district to another. Property moved between May and July, the assessor of personal property removing from one county, town, or district into this state from another state between said dates shall list the property owned by him on May 1 of such year in the county, town, or district to which he is first called upon to list.

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Sec. 273.49. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property for himself, for any other person, company, or corporation, has not made a full and true statement of his personal property, he may require the full oath in regard to the amount of the property to be required to be sworn to by the person assessed.

Sec. 520.05. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who shall be assessed for taxes on real or personal property, or who is authorized by law to make a return of such property for taxation, or who shall be assessed, who shall willfully make any statement as to the value of any kind of property for taxation, which he knows to be false, shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

Sec. 273.13. Classification of property-Subdivision 1. How classified. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax shall be classified for purposes of taxation as follows:

Subdivision 2. Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined shall constitute class one and shall be valued and assessed at fifty per cent of its true and full value.

Class 1a. All direct products of the blast and open hearth furnaces, whether or not further processed, shall constitute class 1a and shall be valued and assessed at 15 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 3. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and all other articles of personal and domestic purposes, used by the owner for personal and domestic purposes, or for the cleaning or maintenance of the property, shall constitute class two and shall be valued and assessed at 25 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a," and class three "d," stocks of merchandise, including grain, hay, and other crops, shall constitute class three, and shall be valued and assessed at 75 per cent of the full and true value thereof. ...

Subdivision 5. Class 3a. All agricultural products, including livestock, shall constitute class 3a and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 6. Class 3b. Livestock, poultry, all horses, mules, dogs, and all other animals, shall constitute class 3b and shall be valued and assessed at 20 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 9. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class four and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 270.07. The commissioner of taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter. Minnesota Statutes 1933, Section 273.03. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks included in each description of property. Minnesota Statutes 1933, Section 273.04. The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$1.50 per day for each day necessarily attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of seven cents per mile, and each board of review member the sum of \$6.00 per day and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

The forms in this book are prescribed for the 1955 assessment by G. HOWARD SPAETH, Commissioner of Taxation.
