Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927.)

Sec. 1934. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All Real and Personal Property in this State, and all Personal property of persons residing therein, . . . is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

Sec. 1941. WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value May 1st, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it in the manner following:

Sec. 1942. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed of this state, shall list all his moneys, credits, bonds, shares of property of such companies or corporations, (within the state), money loaned or invested, annuities, franchisees, royalties, and such taxes shall be a lien upon such logs and timber, which due from or owing by any such company or corporation.

Sec. 1943. Personal property of a minor, child or insane person shall be listed by the guardian, or of the person having such property in charge, trust, by the trustee; of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.

Sec. 1944. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper officer.

Sec. 1945. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.

Sec. 1946. The property of partnerships and other unincorporated associations, by such persons in the name of the partnership or association provided. Personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the owner, agent, or trustee resides.

Sec. 2008. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property, which is the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer, carried out, provided, that logs and timber cut from lands within, and used in the taxing district where found on May 1st, and all other property, shall be listed in the different towns of the county and such taxes shall be a lien upon such logs and timber, which due from or owing by any such company or corporation.

Sec. 2009. Farm property of assessors. When the owner of a farm property of assessors, or of a person having such property in charge, trust, by the trustee; of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.

Sec. 2010. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper officer.

Sec. 2011. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.

Sec. 2012. The property of partnerships and other unincorporated associations, by such persons in the name of the partnership or association provided.

Sec. 2013. Personal property of electric light and power companies having a third class or higher franchise shall be listed with and assessed by the Minnesota tax commission in the county where situated.

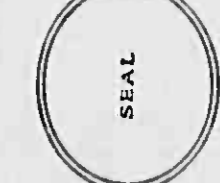
