Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED
Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, *** is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

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Sec. 273.02. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:
1. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent thereof,
2. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof,
3. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent,
4. The property of a non-resident, when the owner is a resident of this state, by the owner,
5. The property of a minor, child or insane person, by the guardian,
6. The property of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator,
7. The property of a corporation whose assets are in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver,
8. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof,
9. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent,
10. The property of a non-resident, when the owner is a resident of this state, by the owner,
11. The property of a minor, child or insane person, by the guardian,
12. The property of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.

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4. The property of a non-resident, when the owner is a resident of this state, by the owner,
5. The property of a minor, child or insane person, by the guardian,
6. The property of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.

Sec. 273.03. Minnesota Statutes 1945. Assessment; Mode. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property.

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The assessors shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state.

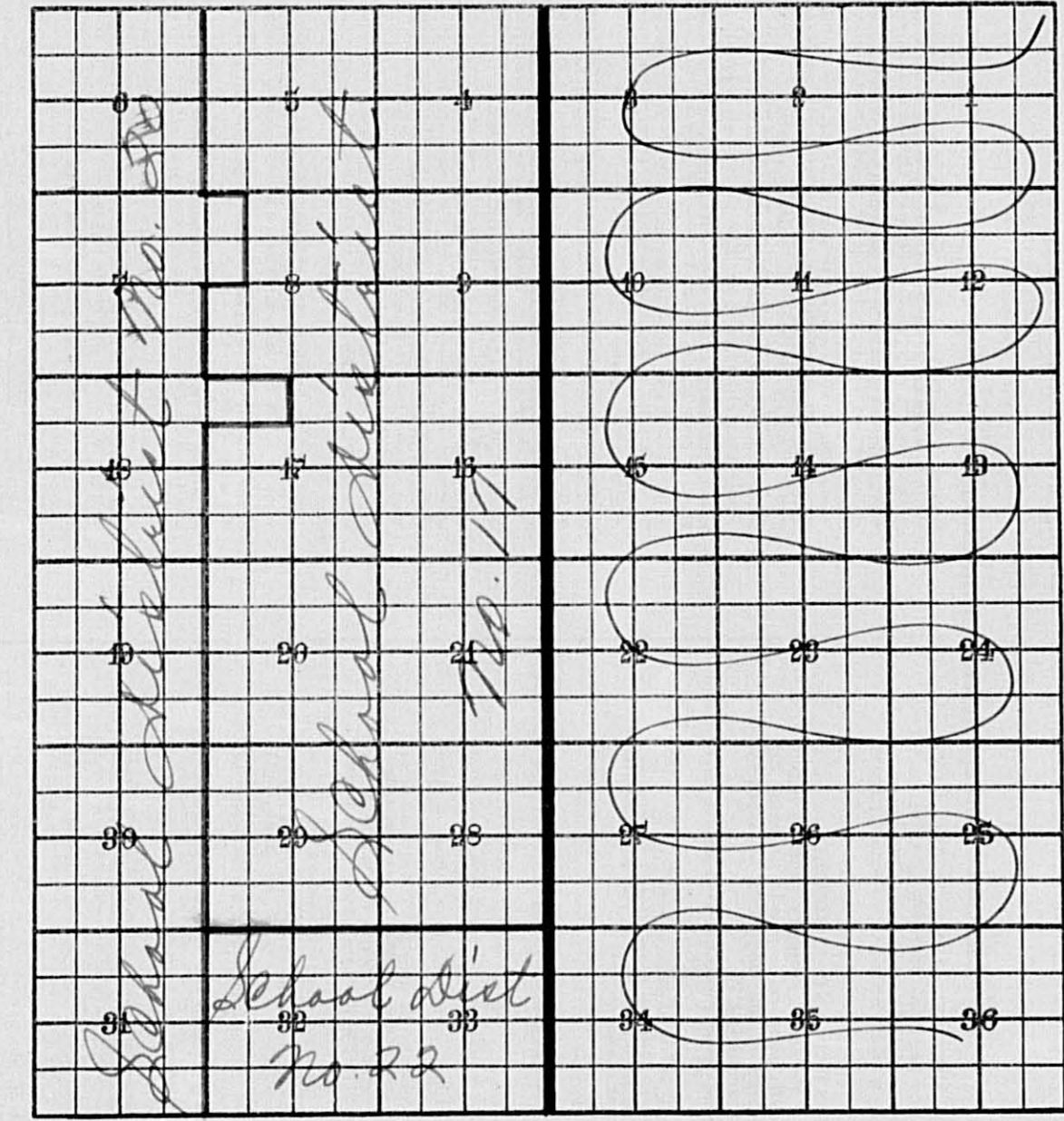

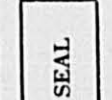
