Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941 as Amended by Laws 1943)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property in foreign countries, which is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed for the persons acquiring it.
Sec. 273.02. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:
1. The executor of a decedent's estate shall list all of his personal property...
2. He shall also list separately, and in the name of his principal, all money and other personal property...
3. The property of a minor, child or insane person shall be listed by his guardian, or by the person having such property in charge...

6. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent thereof.

8. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent...
9. The property of a partnership, by any partner thereof...

Sec. 273.03. Minnesota Statutes 1941. Assessment; Mode. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown so stated, opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description...
Sec. 273.04. Manufacturers. Every manufacturer required to list his property shall also the value of all articles purchased, received, or otherwise held by him from any other place for the sole purpose of being stored on credit from its sale...
Sec. 273.05. Pipeline companies. Personal property of pipeline, oil, or other petroleum products shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept...
Sec. 273.06. Assignments and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment...
Sec. 273.07. Property moved from one county, town, or district...
Sec. 273.08. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the proper place for listing and assessing such property, the place for listing and assessing shall be determined by the county, town, or district in which the property is located...
Sec. 273.09. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor may, after giving notice to the person liable to list, assess the same at such amount as he believes to be the true value thereof...
Sec. 273.10. Assessor may enter dwellings, etc. Any officer authorized by law to assess property for taxation may, when necessary to the proper performance of his duties, enter any dwelling, building, or structure, and view the same and the property therein...
Sec. 273.11. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, in making any statement, oral or written, which is required or authorized by law to be made, or in making any return, or in making any assessment, who shall wilfully make any statement as to any material matter which he knows to be false, shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor...
Sec. 273.12. Classification of property. Personal property shall be classified as follows:
1. Class 1. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax and not subject to any gross earnings or other lieu tax...
2. Class 2. All household goods and furniture...
3. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a," and class three "b," stocks of merchandise...
4. Class 4. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a," and class three "b," stocks of merchandise...
5. Class 5. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a," and class three "b," stocks of merchandise...
6. Class 6. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a," and class three "b," stocks of merchandise...

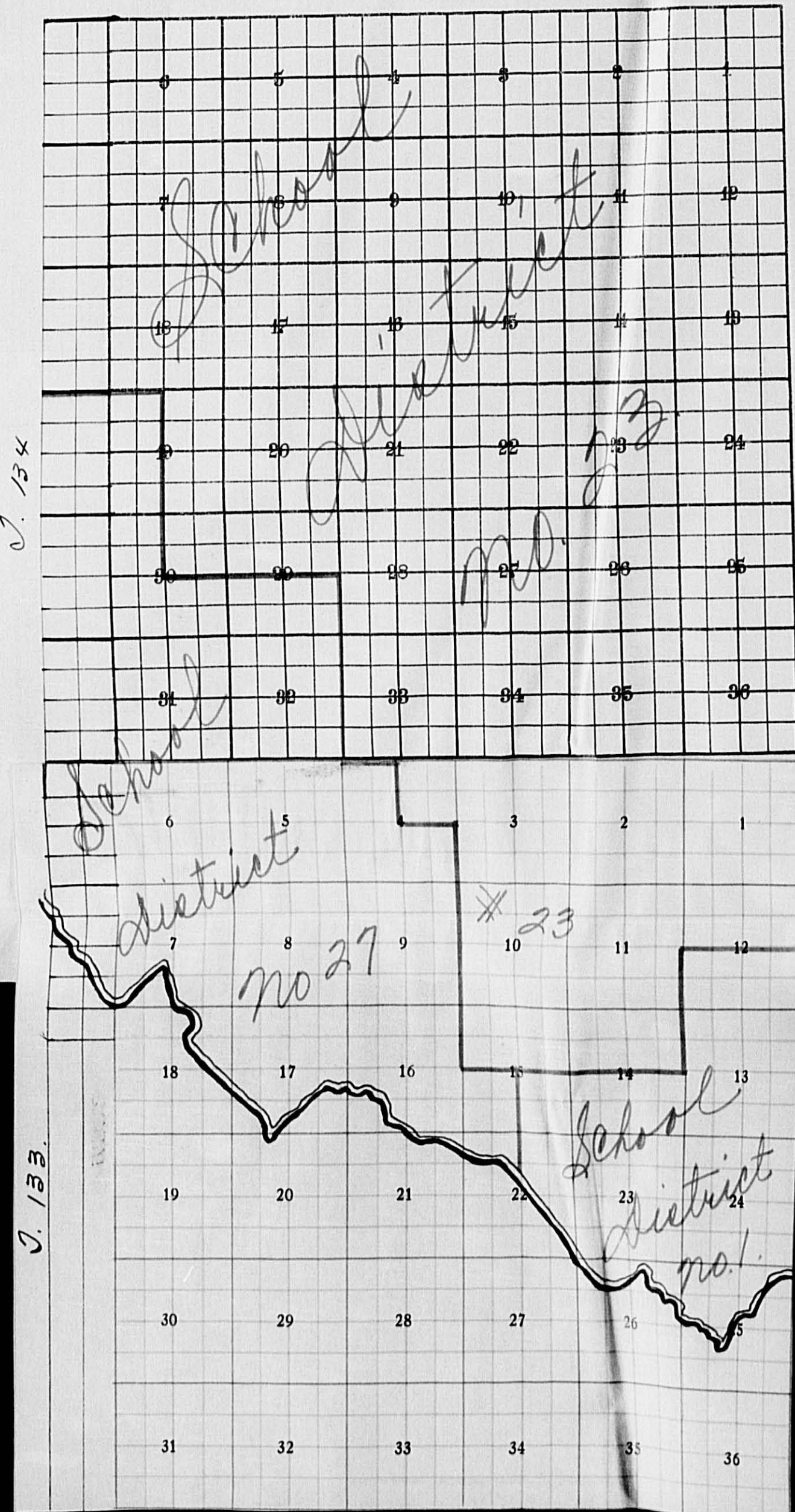

The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown so stated, opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description...
the third Monday in APRIL of each year.
The assessors shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of four dollars per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.
