According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the contained a list of all Real Estate that has become subject to taxation since the Assessment of May 1, 1964, so far as the same has come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess such Real Estate and all Personal Property, and make such changes in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof as required by the laws of the State of Minnesota prescribing the duties of the assessor.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property

Section Numbers refer to Minnesota Statutes

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, . . . is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01 . . . Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.32. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. The property of a resident of this state, shall list all of his . . . and second mortgage on real estate, shall list all of the . . . controlled by him as agent or attorney . . .

Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of real estate in this state shall be listed and assessed in the town or district in which the principal place of business of such farm is located, with the machinery and fixtures thereon, situated upon the premises, with the machinery and fixtures thereon, situated upon the premises, and real estate thereon, situated upon the premises, and assessed as personal property in the town or district where the business and manufacturing of the personal property is carried on . . .

Sec. 273.33. Pipeline Companies. Subdivision 1. Personal property of . . . pipeline companies engaged in the business of transporting gas or oil through the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept. 2. The personal property of pipeline companies and others engaged in the operations or business of transporting gas or oil through the county, town, or district, shall be listed with and assessed by the Commissioner of Taxation through the pipeline to the limits of local companies engaged primarily in the business of distributing gas to supply natural gas or other petroleum products exclusively to the public, before the fifteenth day of November, the commissioner shall certify to the assessor of each county in which such company is located.

Sec. 273.37. Electric Light and Power Companies and others supplying electric light and power. Subdivision 1. Personal property of electric light and power companies, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where situated, except as otherwise provided. Subdivision 2. All transmission and distribution lines, and equipment, poles, towers, and towers, except distribution lines, shall be listed and assessed in the county where situated, before the fifteenth day of November, the commissioner shall certify to the assessor of each county and person owning such property.

Sec. 273.23. Merchants; Confessors. Every merchant required to list his business as a merchant, so consigned shall be required to list for taxation any property the product of this state, nor the value of

any property considered to him from any other place for the purpose of being stored or forwarded, if he has no interest in such property, and derives no profit from its sale. Every manufacturer required to list his property shall state also the value of any machinery required to list his property for the purpose of being used, in whole or in part, in the manufacture of any article, and the value of any tools, fixtures, and implements used in the manufacture of any article, and the value of all engines, machinery, and implements used or been considered real property.

Sec. 273.44. Estates of decedents. The personal property of the decedent at the time of his death, shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing at the time of his death. Sec. 273.45. Persons under Guardianship. The personal property of a person under guardianship shall be listed and assessed where the guardian resides, and every other person under guardianship, where the ward resides.

Sec. 273.46. Addresses and residences. Personal property in the hands of a person shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment. Sec. 273.47. Property moved between May and July. The owner of real estate in this state shall be listed and assessed in either this state from such date upon by the assessor. A person moving into this state from another state on or after May 1 of such year, in the county, town, or district where he is to reside, shall be listed and assessed as if he had moved on May 1 of such year.

Sec. 273.48. Where listed in case of death. In case of death at the proper place of listing personal property or where it cannot be listed, the place for listing and assessing shall be determined by the assessor in different situations, and if the assessor determines that the amount of the property to be listed and assessed is so small that it is not worth the trouble of listing, he may list and assess the property at the place of listing. From one acre to less than one and one-half acres, shall be valued and assessed at 20 per cent of its true and full value. . . . Class 2. All land used for agricultural purposes, shall be valued and assessed at 33 1/3 per cent of its true and full value. . . . Class 3. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer, shall be valued and assessed at 20 per cent of its true and full value. . . . Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be valued and assessed at 40 per cent of its true and full value.

Minnesota Statutes, Section 270.07. The commissioner of taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter. . . . Minnesota Statutes, Section 273.03. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks included in each description of property. . . . Minnesota Statutes, Section 273.04. The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$7.50 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of seven cents per mile, and each board of review member the sum of \$6.00 per day and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.
