Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter... Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 273.03, as amended. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district... The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state... The sum of \$6.00 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

The forms in this book are prescribed for the 1952 assessment by G. HOWARD SPAETH, Commissioner of Taxation.
