Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941 as Amended by Laws 1943)

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, \*\*\* is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

Sec. 272.02. WHEN LISTED. Personal property shall be listed in this state, shall list all of his \*\*\* personal property, all money he has owned, loaned, or otherwise received by him as agent or attorney, \*\*\*.

Sec. 272.03. ESTATES OF DECEASED. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver.

Sec. 272.04. ESTATES OF DECEDENTS. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing at the time of the decedent's death, or in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver.

Sec. 272.05. PERSONAL PROPERTY OF ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER COMPANIES. The personal property of electric light and power companies having a fixed situs in any city, town, or borough in this state shall be listed and assessed where situated.

Sec. 272.06. PERSONAL PROPERTY OF ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER COMPANIES OUTSIDE OF CITIES AND VILLAGES. The personal property of electric light and power companies having a fixed situs in any city, town, or borough in this state shall be listed and assessed where situated.

Sec. 272.07. MANUFACTURERS. Every manufacturer shall list his personal property in the hands of the manufacturer, or in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver.

Sec. 272.08. PIPELINE COMPANIES. The personal property of pipeline companies engaged in the business of transporting gas, oil, or other fluids through pipes, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 272.09. FARM PROPERTY OF NON-RESIDENTS. When the owner of real estate in this state is a non-resident, the personal property of such owner shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 272.10. FARM PROPERTY OF RESIDENTS. When the owner of real estate in this state is a resident, the personal property of such owner shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 272.11. CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY. Subdivision 1. How classified for purposes of taxation as provided by the law.

Subdivision 2. Class 1. From the date of listing and assessed at fifty per cent of its true and full value. If unmined, it shall be assessed with and as a part of the real estate in which it is situated.

Subdivision 3. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other articles of personal use, shall be assessed at 25 per cent of the full value.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a", and class three "b", shall be assessed at 25 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 5. Class 3a. All agricultural products in the hands of the grower, packer, or dealer, shall be assessed at 25 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 6. Class 3b. All agricultural products in the hands of the grower, packer, or dealer, shall be assessed at 25 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 7. Class 3c. All agricultural products in the hands of the grower, packer, or dealer, shall be assessed at 25 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 8. Class 3d. Livestock, poultry, all horses, mules, and other animals, and machinery used by the owner in any agricultural pursuit shall constitute class three "d" and shall be valued and assessed at 25 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 9. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class four and shall be valued and assessed at 25 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Sec. 108.01. The county auditor shall be assessed at 5 per cent of the true and full value thereof.

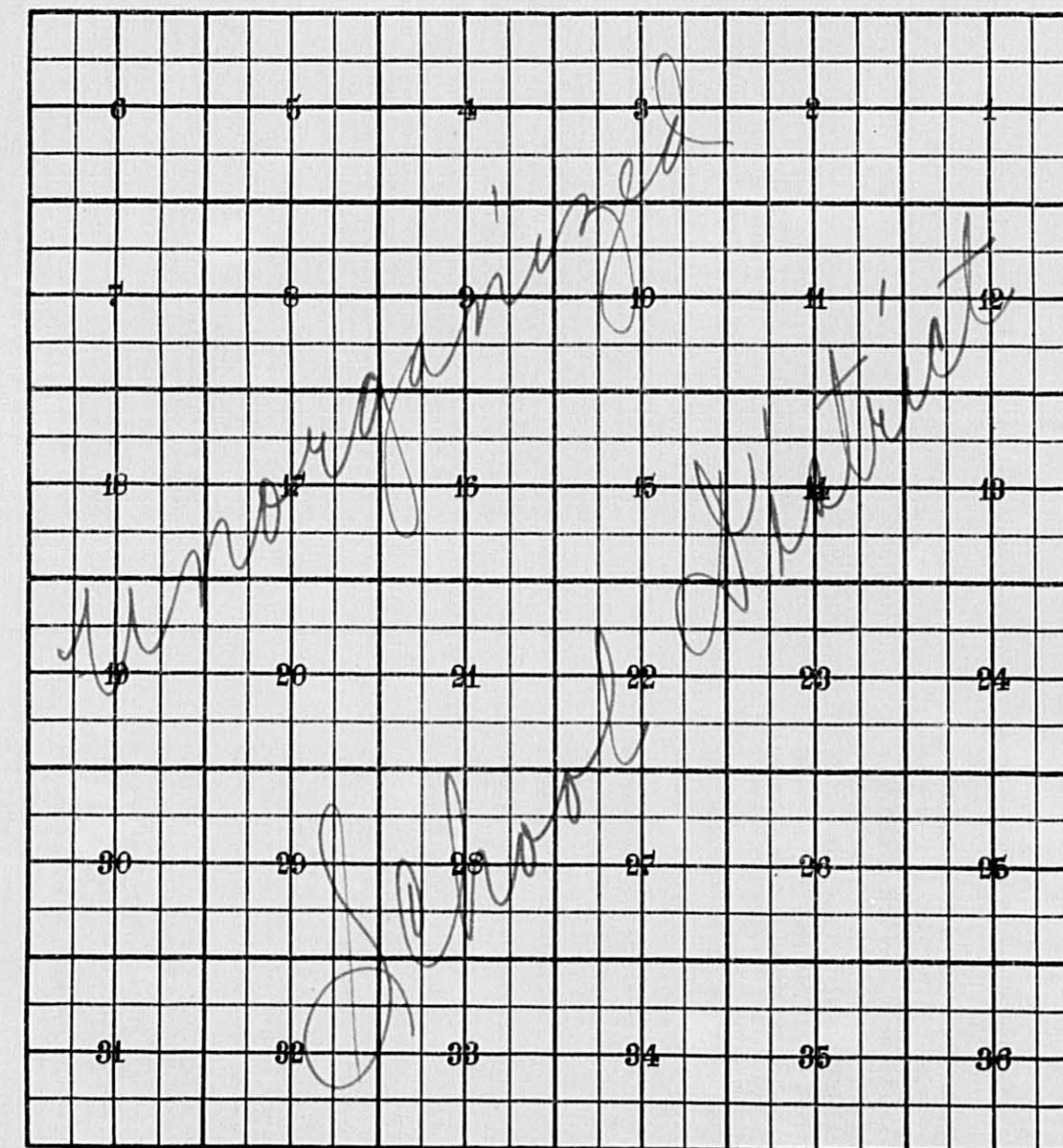

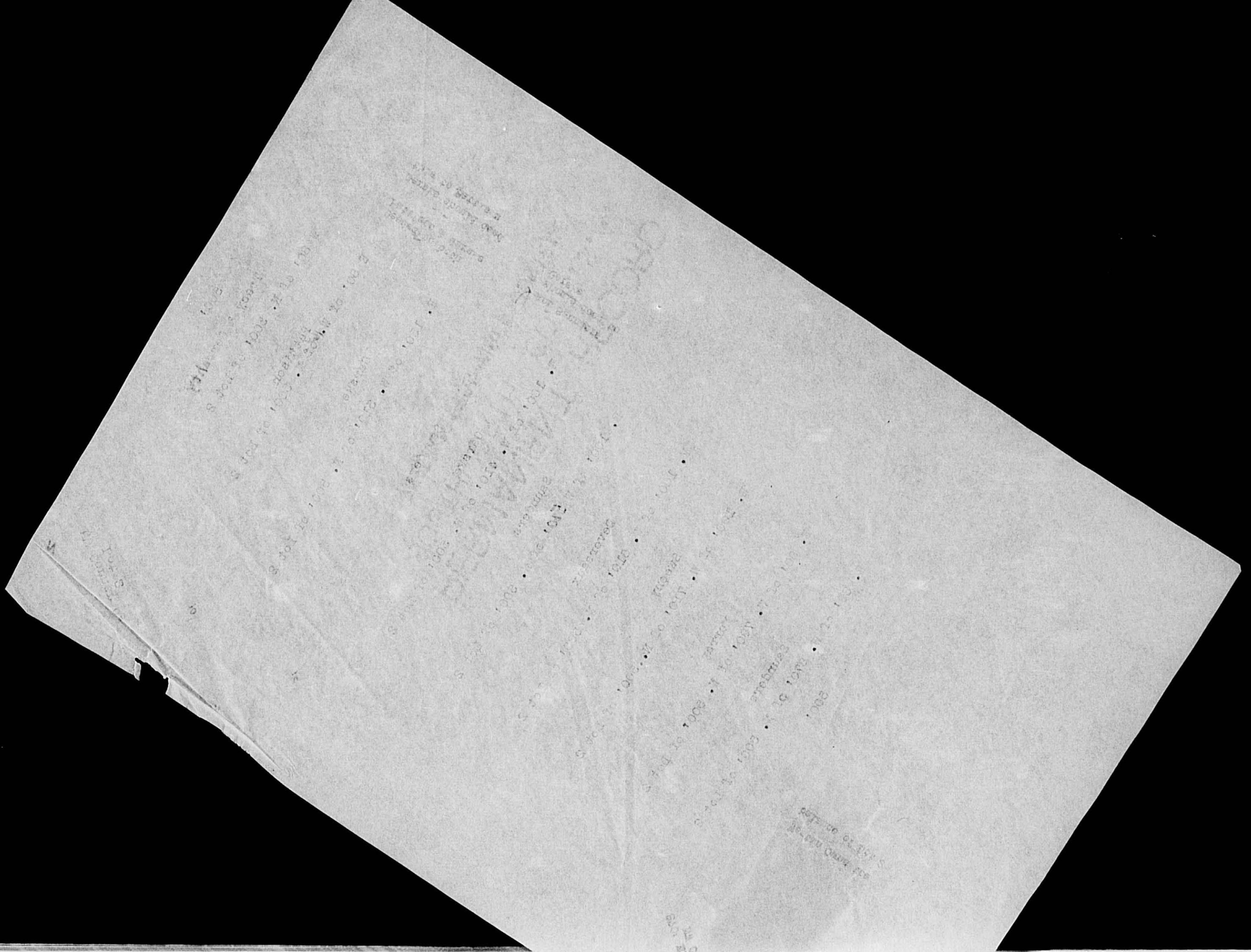
