Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927.)

Sec. 1974. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, . . . is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 1984. . . Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if, acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 1999. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his . . . personal property.

Sec. 2003. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the owner, agent or trustee resides.

Sec. 2005. Merchants and carriers. Personal property of merchants and carriers shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where their business is carried on.

Sec. 2006. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of farm property is a non-resident, the property shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the farm is situated.

Sec. 2008. Elevators, etc., on railroads. All elevators, warehouses, with the machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon the land of any railroad company which are not in good faith owned, leased, or controlled by the railroad company shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 2012. Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the property is situated.

Sec. 2014. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the time of his death.

Sec. 2015. Persons under guardianship. The personal property of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed where the guardian resides, or every other person under guardianship, where the ward resides.

Sec. 2016. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment.

Sec. 2017. Property moved between May and July. The personal property of a person moving from one town or district to another between May 1 and July 1, shall be listed in the town or district in which he is first called upon by the assessor.

Sec. 2018. Personal property of non-resident. When the owner of personal property is a non-resident, the property shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the property is situated.

Sec. 2020. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, for the purpose of evading the payment of taxes, shall file a false statement regarding the value of his property, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offense.

Sec. 2021. Penalties for non-compliance. Any person who fails to list and assess his personal property as required by law, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offense.

Sec. 1928. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list his property shall verify the same by taking an oath before a justice of the peace, or a notary public, or a clerk of the court, or a commissioner of the land office, or a county auditor, or a county assessor, or a member of the county board of equalization, and if between different counties, the clerk of the county in which the property is situated, or in any other place in different counties, by the Department of Taxation.

Sec. 2022. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property for himself or for any other person, company, or corporation, has not made a full, correct, and complete return of the property, he may administer an oath in regard to the amount of the property, and if such person shall refuse to make full discovery under oath, he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offense.

Sec. 2023. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a list of the personal property of a decedent, the assessor may, at his discretion, estimate the value of such property, and assess the same at such amount as he shall deem and believe to be the true value thereof.

Sec. 1997. Assessor may enter dwellings, etc. Any officer authorized by law to assess property for taxation may, when necessary for the performance of his duties, enter any dwelling house, building, or structure, and view the same and the property therein.

Sec. 10206. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, for the purpose of evading the payment of taxes, shall file a false statement regarding the value of his property, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offense.

Sec. 10207. Penalties for non-compliance. Any person who fails to list and assess his personal property as required by law, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offense.

Sec. 10208. Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the property is situated.

Sec. 10214. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the time of his death.

Sec. 10215. Persons under guardianship. The personal property of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed where the guardian resides, or every other person under guardianship, where the ward resides.

Sec. 10216. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment.

Sec. 10217. Property moved between May and July. The personal property of a person moving from one town or district to another between May 1 and July 1, shall be listed in the town or district in which he is first called upon by the assessor.

Sec. 10218. Personal property of non-resident. When the owner of personal property is a non-resident, the property shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the property is situated.

Sec. 10220. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, for the purpose of evading the payment of taxes, shall file a false statement regarding the value of his property, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offense.

Sec. 10221. Penalties for non-compliance. Any person who fails to list and assess his personal property as required by law, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offense.
