To Assessor of the County, Minn.

According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the year 1963, for the year 1963, as the same has come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess such Real Estate and all Personal Property, and make such changes in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof as required by the laws of Minnesota prescribing the duties of the assessor.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property

Section Numbers refer to Minnesota Statutes

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, . . . is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 272.01. . . . Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually on its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. The property of a full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall be listed by the owner.

Sec. 273.26. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, the assessment shall be made in the county, town, or district where the owner, agent or trustee resides.

Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property; where listed. All household machinery, excepting upward of one piece of household machinery, owned by the owner for personal and domestic purposes, or for the farming business, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.29. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property of a merchant or manufacturer shall be listed in the town or district where his business is carried on.

Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of a farm is a non-resident, the assessment shall be made in the county, town, or district where the farm is situated.

Sec. 273.32. Gas and Water Companies. The personal property of a gas or water company shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.33. Electric, Light and Power Companies. The personal property of an electric, light and power company shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.34. Electric, Light and Power Companies. The personal property of an electric, light and power company shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.47. Property removed from one county, town, or district to another. The assessor shall be notified of any such removal, and he shall assess the property in the county, town, or district to which it is removed.

The forms in this book are prescribed for the 1963 assessment by The Commissioner of Taxation

Minnesota Statutes, Section 270.07. The commissioner of taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter . . .

Minnesota Statutes, Section 273.03. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each taxation district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to assessment, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks included in each description of property. . . .

Minnesota Statutes, Section 273.04. The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$7.50 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of seven cents per mile, and each board of review member the sum of \$6.00 per day and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

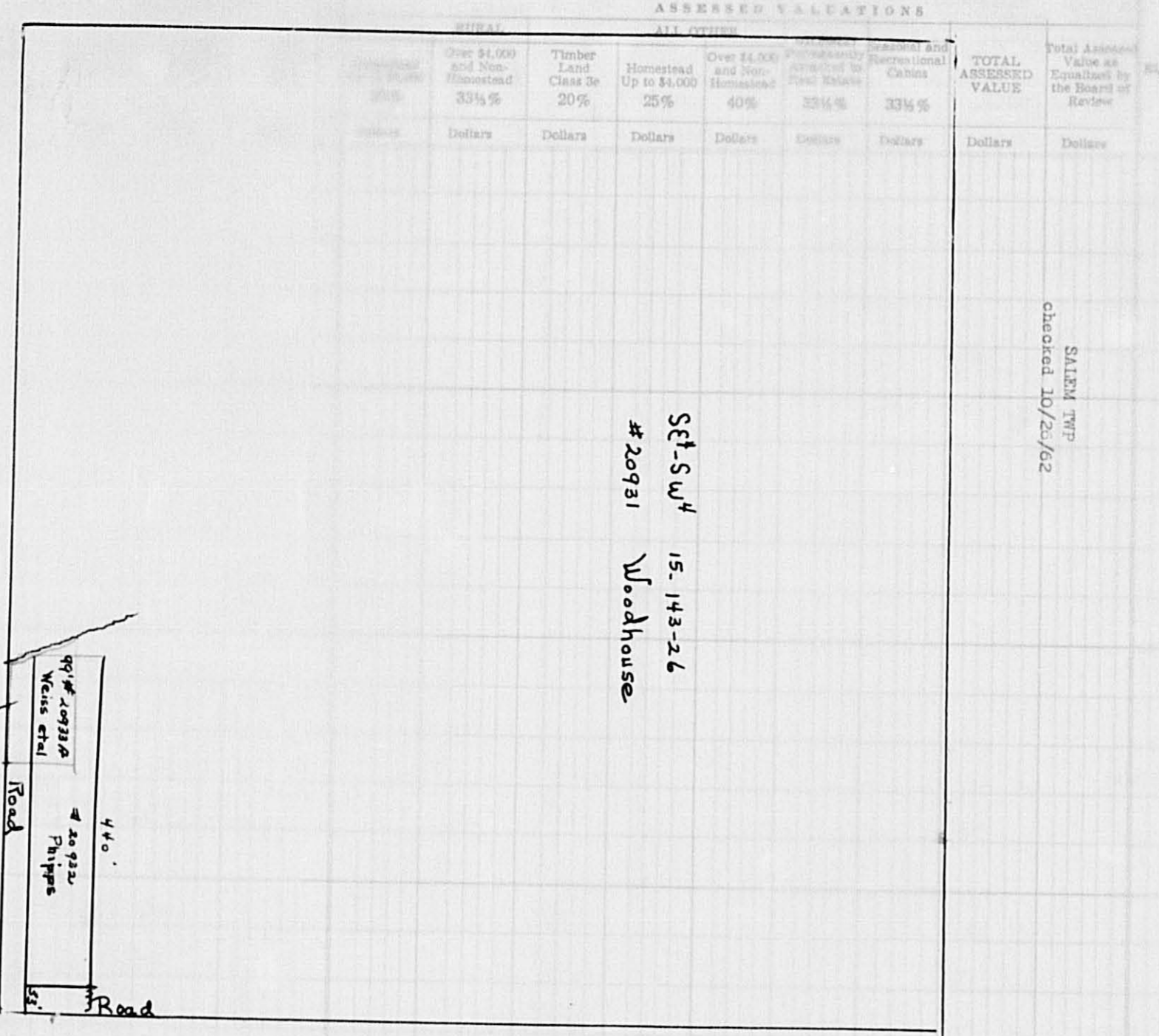
