Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1913)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. Real and personal property in this state, and all personal property owned by a resident therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually by the assessor on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.25. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the proper place of listing personal property or where it cannot be listed in any one place, the assessor shall determine the county, the place for listing and assessing shall be determined by the board of equalization, and if between different counties, or places in different counties, by the Department of Taxation.

Sec. 273.25. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list personal property owned by him on May 1 of the current year, shall also list for taxation as agent or attorney, partner, trustee, or in any other capacity.

Sec. 273.65. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property for himself, for another, as agent or attorney, partner, trustee, or in any other capacity, has not listed the same, he may examine such person under oath in regard to the amount of the property he is required to list, and the assessor may list the property of such person on his oath according to his best judgment and information.

Sec. 273.66. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount as he believes to be the true value thereof. When requested, he shall sign and deliver to the person assessed a copy of the statement, and the person assessed shall be required to sign and return to the assessor a statement of the amount of the property he is required to list, and the assessor may list the property of such person on his oath according to his best judgment and information.

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Sec. 273.13. Classification of property—Subdivision 1. How classified for purposes of taxation as provided by this section.

Subdivision 2. Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined and all waste therefrom, and all machinery, tools, and implements used in the mining of iron ore, and all buildings, structures, and other improvements on land used in the mining of iron ore.

Subdivision 3. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including all articles of personal use, and all personal property, except as provided in this section.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided in this section.

Subdivision 5. Class 3a. All agricultural products, except as provided in this section.

Subdivision 6. Class 3b. All agricultural products, except as provided in this section.

Subdivision 7. Class 3c. All agricultural products, except as provided in this section.

Subdivision 8. Class 3d. All agricultural products, except as provided in this section.

Subdivision 9. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes, and assessed at 20 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 10. Class 5. All agricultural products, except as provided in this section.
