DIRECTIONS TO ASSESSOR

OFFICE OF COUNTY AUDITOR, County, Minn., 1948.

According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Real and Personal Property Assessment Books for the said ... for the year 1948, containing a list of all Real Estate subject to taxation, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess all Property and make return thereof to me as required by the laws of the State of Minnesota prescribing the duties of the assessor.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all ... is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed by: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his ... personal property.

Sec. 273.26. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county in which the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.37. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages, personal property of electric street car companies having a fixed trolley in any city, village, or town, and personal property of electric trolley companies, shall be listed and assessed in the county where the principal place of business of such company is located.

Sec. 273.38. Personal property of non-resident. When the owner of livestock or other personal property is a non-resident of this state, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or city of the first class, of electric light and power companies, and of other individuals and partnerships supplying electric power, having a fixed trolley in any city, village, or town, and of electric trolley companies, shall be listed and assessed by the assessor of the county where such property is located.

Sec. 273.40. Personal property of manufacturers. The personal property pertaining to the business of manufacturers, the principal place of business of which is in the town or district where his business is carried on ...

Sec. 273.41. Personal property of manufacturers. The personal property of manufacturers and others in the hands of a partner, or agent, or other person, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.42. Personal property of manufacturers. The personal property of manufacturers and others in the hands of a partner, or agent, or other person, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.43. Personal property of manufacturers. The personal property of manufacturers and others in the hands of a partner, or agent, or other person, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.44. Personal property of manufacturers. The personal property of manufacturers and others in the hands of a partner, or agent, or other person, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.45. Personal property of manufacturers. The personal property of manufacturers and others in the hands of a partner, or agent, or other person, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.46. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the place for listing and assessing shall be determined by the assessor of the county in which the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.47. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list his personal property shall verify the same by a sworn statement of the value of such property, and shall file the same with the assessor of the county in which the principal place of business of such person is located.

Sec. 273.48. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor has reason to believe that the value of the property listed is not correct, he may examine such person under oath in regard to the amount of the property he is required to list, and the assessor may list the property of such person or his principal according to the best judgment and information.

Sec. 273.49. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, in making any statement, oral or written, which is required to be made by him in connection with the assessment of his personal property, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100, or to imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or to both, if he makes a false statement which he knows to be false, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 273.50. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. How classified. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax shall be classified as follows: Class 1. Real estate, including land, buildings, and other improvements thereon, and all other real estate, except as otherwise provided by law.

Subdivision 2. Class 1. From one whether titled or untitled shall constitute Class one and shall be valued and assessed at fifty per cent of the true and full value thereof, and shall be assessed at the rate provided in the schedule of rates in which it is located.

Subdivision 3. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including household goods and furniture, and all other personal property, except as otherwise provided by law, shall be valued and assessed at thirty per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by law, shall be valued and assessed at twenty per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 5. Class 4. All personal property, except as provided by law, shall be valued and assessed at ten per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 6. Class 5. All personal property, except as provided by law, shall be valued and assessed at five per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 7. Class 6. All personal property, except as provided by law, shall be valued and assessed at three per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Subdivision 8. Class 7. All personal property, except as provided by law, shall be valued and assessed at one per cent of the true and full value thereof.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.03, as amended. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the form of a property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property.

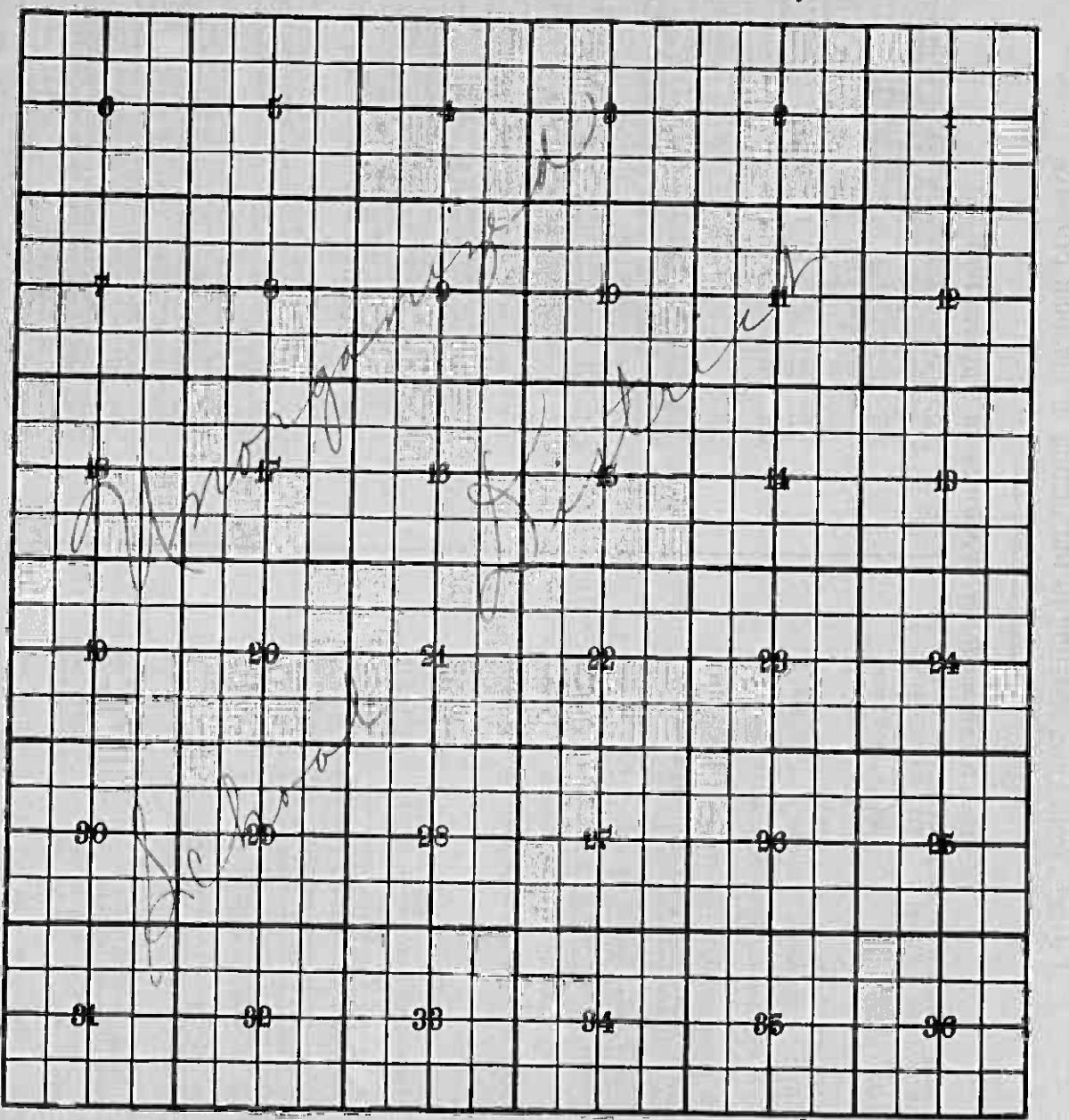
The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor and board of review member attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$6.00 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meetings, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county-seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

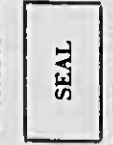
