On this 23rd day of July, A. D. 1915, before me, a Notary Public within and for said County, appeared Jas. D. Middleton, a surveyor, to me personally known, who, having been by me duly sworn, did say, that, on the 26th day of April, 1913, in the presence of D. F. Case, I. L. Dean and Murphy, he located the corner to Secs. 25, 30, 31 & 33, T. 145 N., R's 27 & 28 W. of the 5th P. M., State and County aforesaid, from one of the bearing trees as described in the field notes of the original survey, which was found by Mr. D. F. Case, as follows:-
Jack Pine, 8 inches in diameter (fallen), S. 65° E., 15 links;
and from the following stumps (badly damaged by fire) that correspond with the directions and distances as returned in the said field notes, as follows:-

Jack Pine, 8 inches in diameter,	N. 54° E., 42 links,
" " " " " "	S. 81° W., 32 "
" " " " " "	N. 49° W., 50 "

and drove a 1 inch round-head, round iron drift bolt at the point for the said corner.

And, that on the 29th day of April, 1913, in presence of B. F. Case, R. L. Dean and Thomas Fitzgerald, he located the 28 corner between Secs. 25 & 30, T. and R's aforesaid, from one of the bearing trees as described in the field notes of the original survey, which was found by Mr. D. F. Case, as follows:-

Norway Pine, 14 inches in diameter (fallen),	N. 52° E., 26 links;
and from a Norway Pine tree (fallen and badly damaged by fire) that	that corresponds in direction and distance as returned in the said
field notes, as follows:-	
Norway Pine, 16 inches in diameter,	S. 34° W., 13 links,

and set a 3 x 3 inches Tamarac post at the point for the said corner. And, that on the 2nd day of June, 1915, in the presence of Barney McGuire, he drove a 1 inch, round iron eye-bolt at the point for the said corner in place of the 3 x 3 inches Tamarac post previously set, and set the said post on the northward side of the said eye-bolt.
