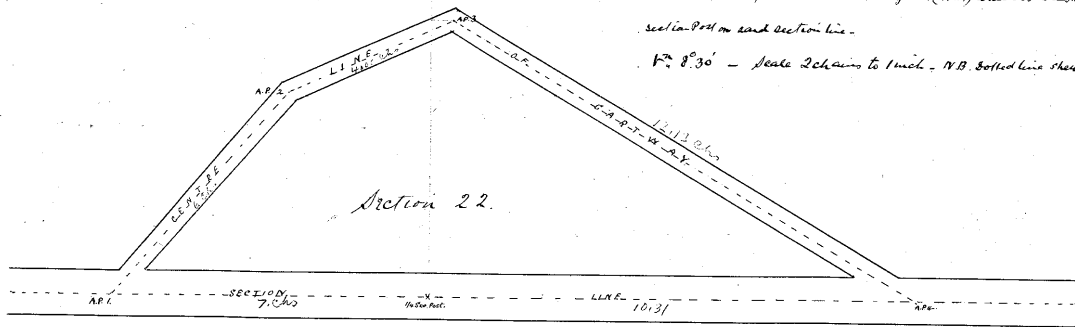




Plat

Notes.

Said cartway (of 20000 wide, i.e. one road on either side of center line of cartway, less stream) commences at a point on the section line lying between section 22 and 27 Twp. 136. Range 30 west of the 5th Principal Meridian - which point is a distance of 7 chains west of the greater section post on said section line. This point (AP1) lies on bearing True & whole Circle 12° S 11° E 270 ft. and a whole Circle 11° S 36° W 262 ft. ✓
From thence (AP1) on a course of N 61 1/2° E a distance of ch. 0.00 to AP2. BT is upon 168° 52' 1/2° E 234 ft. or 8° 54' E 126 ft.
" (AP2) " N 69° E " ch. 4.00 to AP3. BT whole Circle 16° W 36° E 328 ft. ✓
" (AP3) " S 62° E " ch. 12.13. AP4. BT whole Circle 10° S 36 1/2° W. 266 ft. ✓
Thence on bearing the section line at this point (AP4) which is a distance of ch. 10.31 east of the greater section post on said section line -
To 8° 30' - Stake 2 chains to 1 inch - NB. dotted line shows center line of road. Feet over
