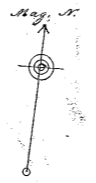

field notes of a survey of the center line for a County Road between Secs. 20 & 29 and 19 & 30, T. 148 N., R. 51 W. of the 5th P. M., Cass County, Minnesota.

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first. The instruments used were a transit and a 100 feet steel chain tape. All bearings are given according to the magnetic meridian, except those of the U. S. D. T.'s (bearing trees), which are given according to the U. S. field notes.

All distances are given in feet and hundredths of a foot, except those of the U. S. D. T.'s, which are given according to the U. S. field notes, in links.

C. R. S. (County Road Survey), refers to State Road No. 1.

C. R. (County Road), refers to the road mentioned in the caption of these field notes.

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Beginning at C. R. S. station 217-34.0, at the corner of Secs. 20, 21, 29 & 29, T. 148 N., R. 51 W., a 4 inches Jack Pine tree for the corner stake (original), with the field records for the sections scribed thereon, and from which bear the following U. S. D. T.'s;

to a X (cross) on top of railroad spikes:

- thence, S. 64° 13' W. to the corner of Secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30, 300.70 Feet. Leave Jack and Norway Pine lands and enter White and Norway Pine and hardwoods land.
- 360.00 Enter marsh.
- 300.00 Leave marsh.
- 1900.00 Enter marsh.
- 2000.00 Leave marsh.
- 3240.00 The corner to Secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30, on a small, a 4 inches hub was set for the corner according to the following U. S. D. T.'s;

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to the head of a spike.

Following Jack and White and Norway Pine and hardwoods lands with stump windfalls and boulders.

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thence, S. 81° 9' W. on the random line, to the Western boundary of the County.

3301.00 Feet to a hub on top of a hill.

The center line of the road from the corner of Secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30 to the county line is not staked out, there being a great difference between what appears to be the old line running westward in Redwood County and the section corner stake recently located for the corner of Secs. 19, 24, 29 & 30.
