

1870 The US General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, show this corner to be marked with a post and the following bearing trees were marked:

Oak 8" S 54° E 33 links (21.78')
Aspen 10" S 15° W 7 links (4.62')

1916 E.B. Horst, Cass County Survey Office, in a resurvey of Ansel Township, searched for evidence of the corner and found nothing. He located the East Quarter Corner of Section 15, the Northeast Corner of Section 10, the northwest corner Section 15 and the northeast corner Section 13. He set the Northeast Corner Section 15 by double proportion and then established this corner by a single proportion method. Distances between the missing quarter corners equal 2635.0'.

1977 MNDOT construction plan for State Highway 64 shows the location for the corner in centerline State Highway 64, but listed nothing found or set. A distance of 2627.0' was listed to the Southeast Corner and 2647.4' to the Northeast Corner of Section 10.

2003 In March, the DNR survey crew searched for evidence of the corner and found a metal attraction in centerline State Highway 64. Nothing east or west.
