

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner of Section 1, Township 138 North, Range 32 West,
5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1860, Township 138 N., Range 32 W. was subdivided and a wood post was set for the Northeast Corner of Section 1. The following bearing trees were recorded:

- 10" W. Birch, S. 30 E., 11 links (7.26 ft.)
- 8" Aspen, S. 75 W., 28 links (18.48 ft.)
- 6" W. Birch, N. 60 E., 32 links (21.12 ft.)
- 8" Aspen, N. 40 W., 11 links (7.26 ft.)

In 1912, John Curo recovered the post and bearing trees recorded by Myers in 1860. A concrete monument measuring 8 inches square by 36 inches long was placed to mark the corner (Book A, page 401).

On September 21, 1927, A.R. Taubman, Assistant Hubbard County Engineer, recovered the references previously set. A concrete monument measuring 4 inches square at the top, 6 inches square at the bottom and 18 inches long was placed to mark this corner and triangular concrete witness monuments were placed North 52 degrees West 46.669 feet, and South 30 degrees West 46.669 feet.

On September 30, 1987, R. Thorpe and M. Branham of the Hubbard County Surveys Office recovered the Southwest concrete witness post placed by Taubman in 1927 and also a railroad spike set flush with the road surface fitting the 1927 reference from the witness post to mark this corner.

On October 14, 1993, Todd Larson and Richard Hilliard of the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the railroad spike found in 1987 to mark this corner.

In January 2004, the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the railroad spike marking the Northeast Corner of Section 1. The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepts the railroad spike as the same railroad spike found by Thorpe and Branham, and Larson and Hilliard which corresponds to the witness monument placed and recorded by Taubman in 1927, marking the position for the Northeast Corner Section 1, Township 138 N., Range 32 W., 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.
