

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner of Section 6, Township 138 North, Range 31 West,
5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1865, Township 138 N., Range 31 W. was subdivided and a wood post was set for the Northeast Corner of Section 6. The following bearing trees were recorded:

- 12" Aspen, N. 34 ½ E., 26 links (17.16 ft.)
- 8" Aspen, N. 15 W., 19 links (12.54 ft.)
- 9" Aspen, S. 25 W., 11 links (7.26 ft.)
- 7" Aspen, S. 43 ¼ E., 11 links (7.26 ft.)

In 1916, John Curo set a 2 ¼ inch by 48 inch iron monument at the location of the original post when he conducted a county resurvey of Section 6. Curo cited four new ties to the Northeast Corner of Section 6, as this time (Book "B", pp 561-563).

In January 2004, the Minnesota Department of Transportation found a 2 ¼" pipe at the location of the Section Corner. The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepts this position as the correct location for the Northeast Corner of Section 6, Township 138 N., Range 31 W., 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.
