

Statement of Evidence:

North Quarter Corner of Section 6, Township 138 North, Range 31 West, 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1865, Township 138 N., Range 31 W. was subdivided and a wood post was set for the North Quarter Corner of Section 6. The following bearing trees were recorded:

16" Aspen, N. 74 E., 26 links (17.16 ft.)

14" Black Pine, S. 8 W., 15 links (9.90 ft.)

In 1916, John Curo set a "Large Spike " at the North Quarter Corner of Section 6 when he resurveyed Section 6 for Cass County. Curo cited two new reference ties at this time (Book "B", pp 561-563).

In January 2004, the Minnesota Department of Transportation, recovered a square spike at the Quarter Corner. The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepts this position as the correct location for the North Quarter Corner of Section 6, Township 138 N., Range 31 W., 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.
