In 1917, Earl G. Harrington, a US Surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner from which he made the following BT's. A 10" jackpine N $78\frac{1}{2}$ E 345. LKS and a 8" red oak S32 E 323 LKS.

On September 24, 1981, Walter E. Curo and Paul Johnson find the brass cap monument in good condition 3" above surface of bog. We find no trace of the original BT's. We make new BT's as shown on front.
