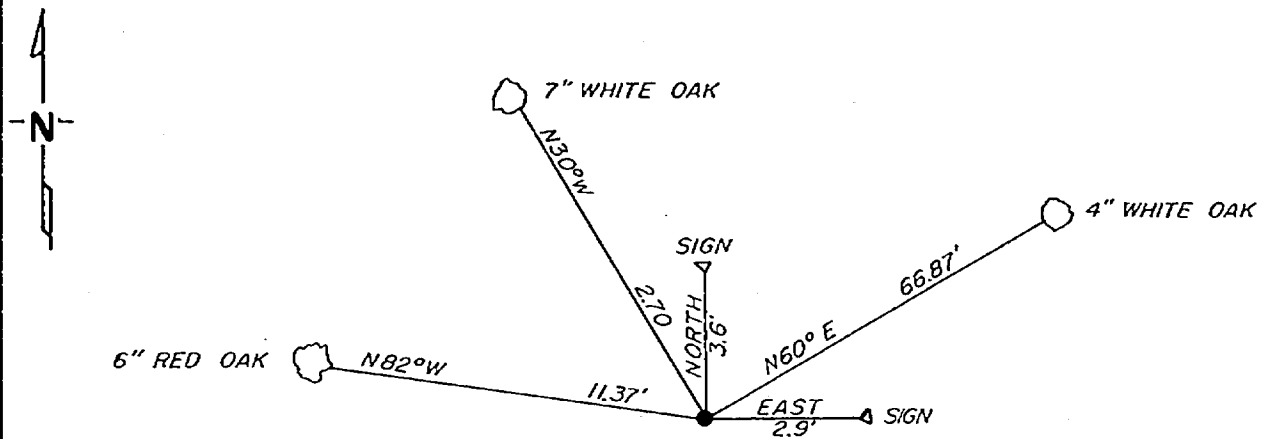

In 1917, Earl G. Harrington, a US surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for AP 3 TR 1664 and AP 4 TR 1663. No Bt's were made.

On October 27, 1981, Walter Curo and Paul Johnson find the brass cap monument standing in good condition from which we make BT's as shown on the front.
