
AP 1 TR 1480 Corner of Section 36, Township 142, Range 30, 5 P.M.

- On 9-14-1981 placed a 2"x60" pipe with brass cap set 42" in ground place 1½"x20" pipe beside it under surface

In 1918, Albinus N. Kimmell, a US Cadestral engineer set a 1"x36" iron pipe with a brass cap for AP 1 TR 1480 and AP 4 TR 1648. No BT's were made.

On September 14, 1981, Walter E. Curo, and Paul Johnson found a 1½" pipe set for this AP. We replace it with a 2"x60" iron pipe with brass cap from which we make BT's as shown on the front.
