Statement of Evidence: North Quarter Corner Section 5, Township 138 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian

In 1865, during the Original Public Land Survey, a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1919, during a road survey, reference was made to an oak stake at this corner in the road.

In 1981 the Minnesota Department of Transportation found a 1" galvanized pipe about 35 feet north of TH 87. The east-west position of this pipe agreed reasonably well with the 1919 road distances. Becasue the pipe was more than 33 feet north of the inplace road centerline and a lost position also was north of the road centerline, it was felt that the pipe represented a 33.00 foot offset from some previous survey position. A cast iron monument was then placed at this position.
