

Statement of Evidence:

- 1930 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 14" Birch N 8 3/4 E 25 links and 7" Ash S 78 3/4 W 39 links.
- 1934 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: CCC records show brass cap monument and the two 1930 bearing trees found. A metal location tag was placed on a 5" Birch N 33 E 11 1/2 links from the corner.
- 1968 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: L. Martinson found the brass cap monument and a Birch snag N 9 E 25 links.
- 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician G. Brama found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 4". The following bearing trees were found: Birch stump N-9 E-16.5'. No evidence found of the Ash. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set 3.4' west and 3.1' south of the corner.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1930 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
