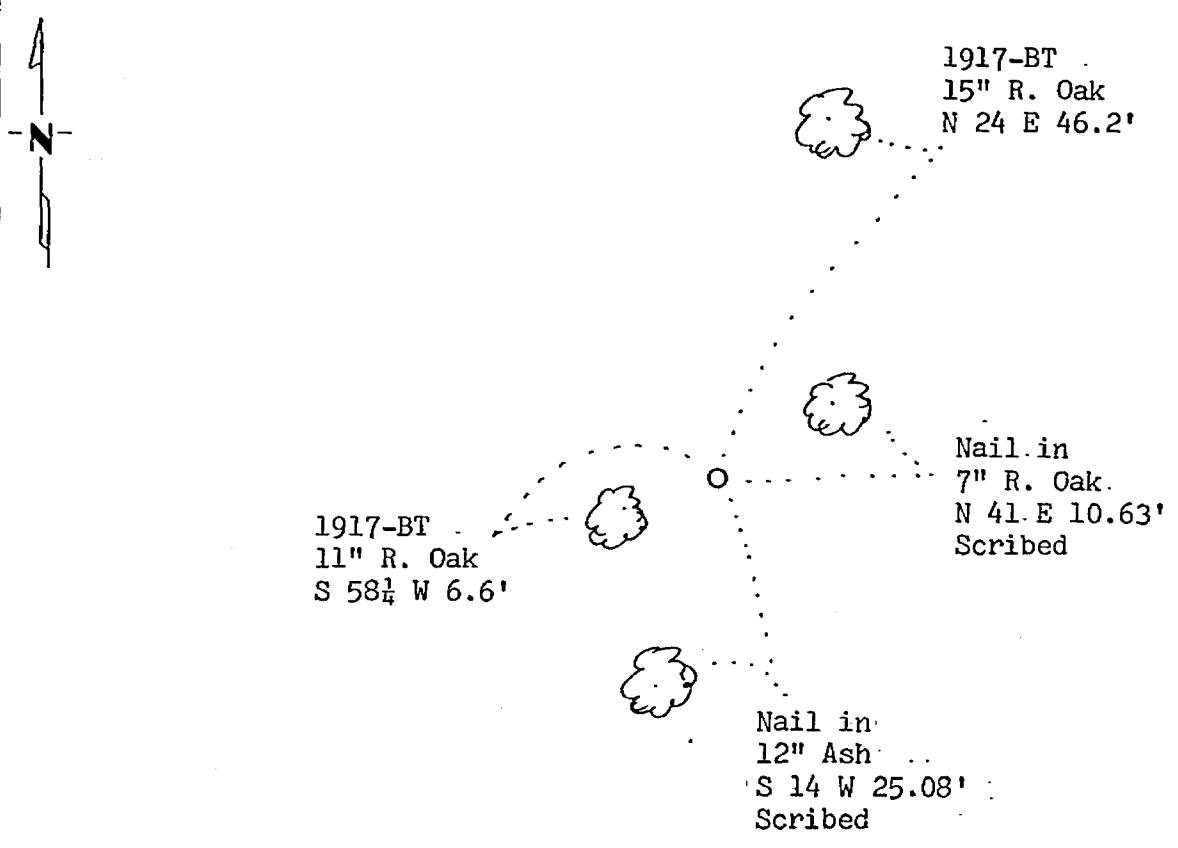

Statement of Evidence:

- 1917 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 5" R. Oak N 24 E 70 links and 5" R. Oak S 58 $\frac{1}{4}$  W 10 links.
- 1940 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: CCC records show brass cap monument found.
- 1981 U.S. Forest Service technician W. Olson found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 0.6'. The following bearing trees were found: 15" R. Oak N 24 E 46.2' and 11" R. Oak S 58 $\frac{1}{4}$  W 6.6'. Two new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1981 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
