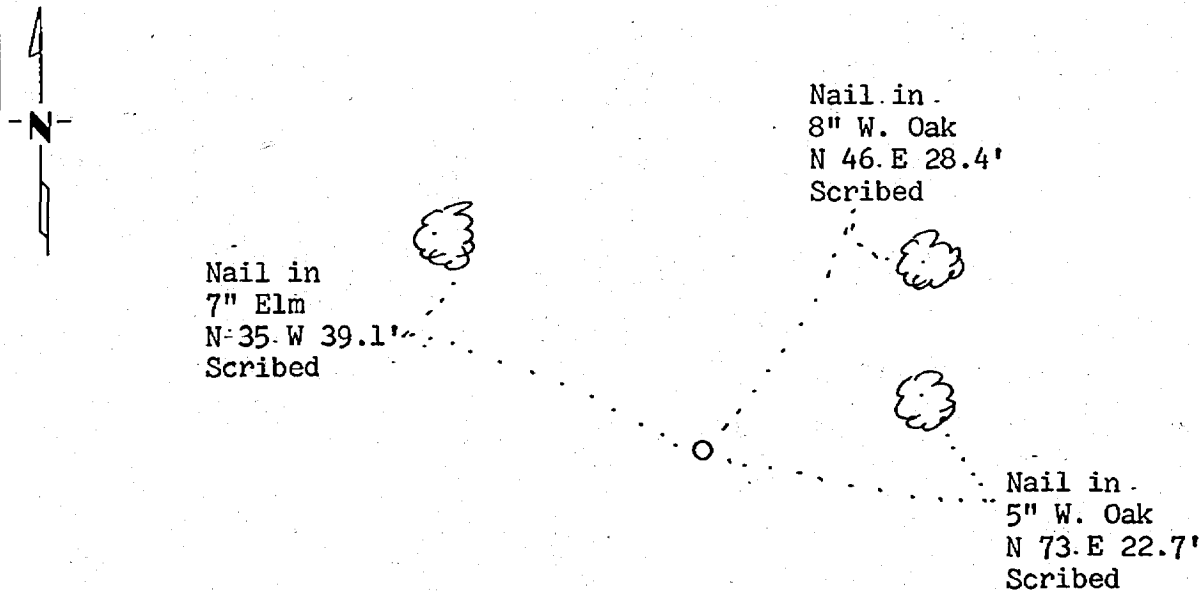

Statement of Evidence:

- 1919 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 12" W. Oak S 63 W 87 links and 10" W. Oak N 24-45 E 63 links.
- 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician J. Schoonover found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 14". The following bearing trees were found: 15" W. Oak (dead) S 63-W 57.4'. No evidence found of the other bearing tree. Three new bearing trees were marked are are shown on this certificate. Corner is on small island surrounded by beaver pond.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
