Statement of Evidence:

- 1919 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 16" W. Pine N 82-15 E 231 links and 20" W. Oak N 76-15 W 92 links.
- U.S. Forest Service technician C. Krause found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 12". The following bearing trees were found: Large Oak stump N-76 W 60.7'. No evidence was found of the W. Pine. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
