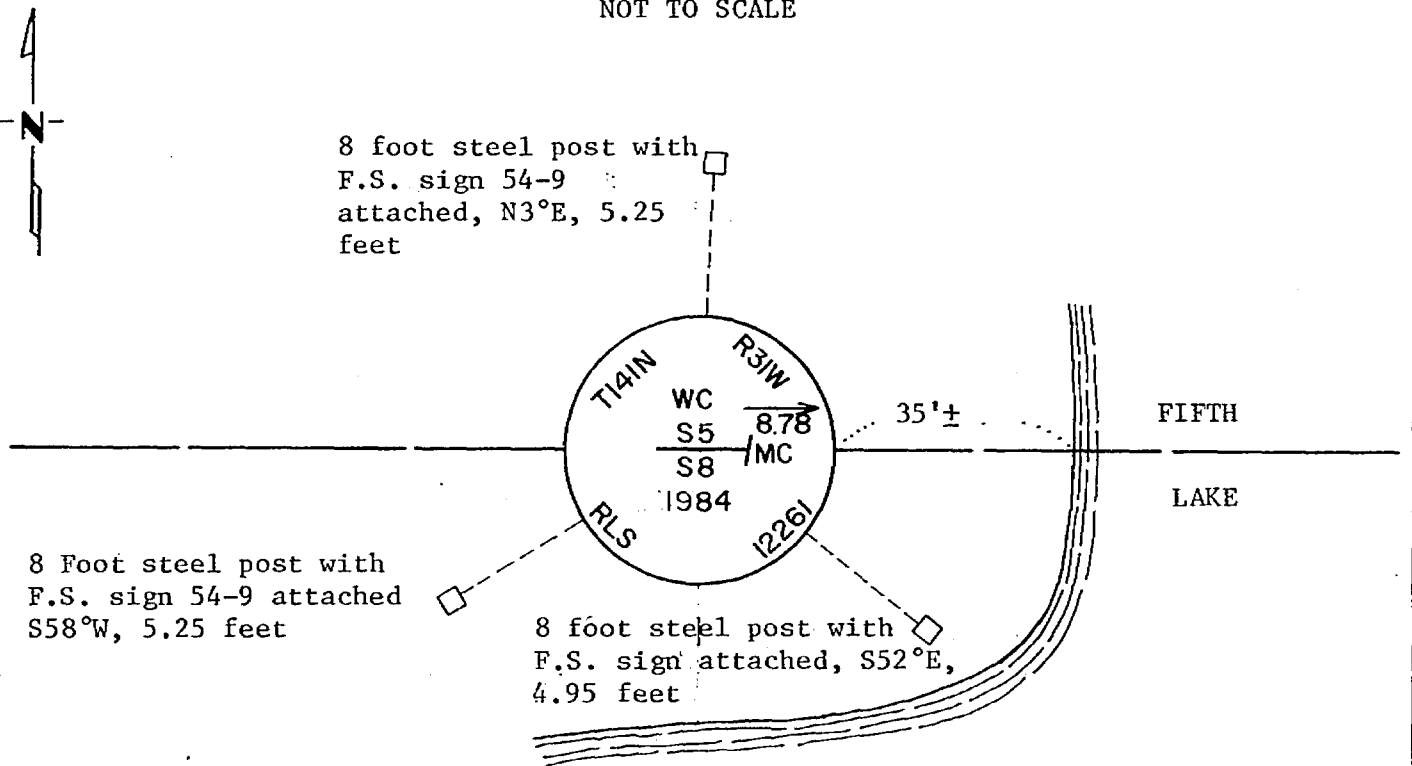

Statement of Evidence: Witness Corner, Meander Corner between Sections 5 & 8,
Township 141 North Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.
West side Fifth Lake.

- 1873 P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, set a post for this Meander Corner in his subdivision of the Township between August 5, 1873 and August 30, 1873. As references he scribed:

- 1979 M. Stefan, R.L.S. and M. Hayes, U.S.F.S., made a thorough search for physical evidence of this corner on January 19, none was found.
- 1984 M. Hayes, U.S.F.S., returned to corner position. At the proportionate position for the lost Meander Corner, between the Meander Corner to the East and the reestablished Quarter Corner to the West, the position was found to fall in a beaver run. A Witness Corner was set which was a 2½ inch (O.D.) x 5 foot long iron pipe with a 3 inch diameter brass cap and references as follows:

- 1984 Kelly M. Booge, under F.S. Contract No. 53-6392-4-00996, made a thorough search on August 30 and found monument and ties in good condition as set by the U.S.F.S. earlier that year as shown on the sketch.
