This corner was originally established in April, 1876, by B.C. Baldwin, Deputy Surveyor. The field notes of that survey are filed in the office of the Secretary of State, St. Paul, Minnesota. Mr. Baldwin's notes state that a post was set to mark the corner and no trees for reference.

On August 13, 1984, personnel from Advance Surveying & Engineering Co. made a thorough search for this corner but to no avail.

On January 8, 1985, an additional search was made by Advance prior to reestablishing this corner at its "lost" position on line between adjacent Section corners and distance prorated.
