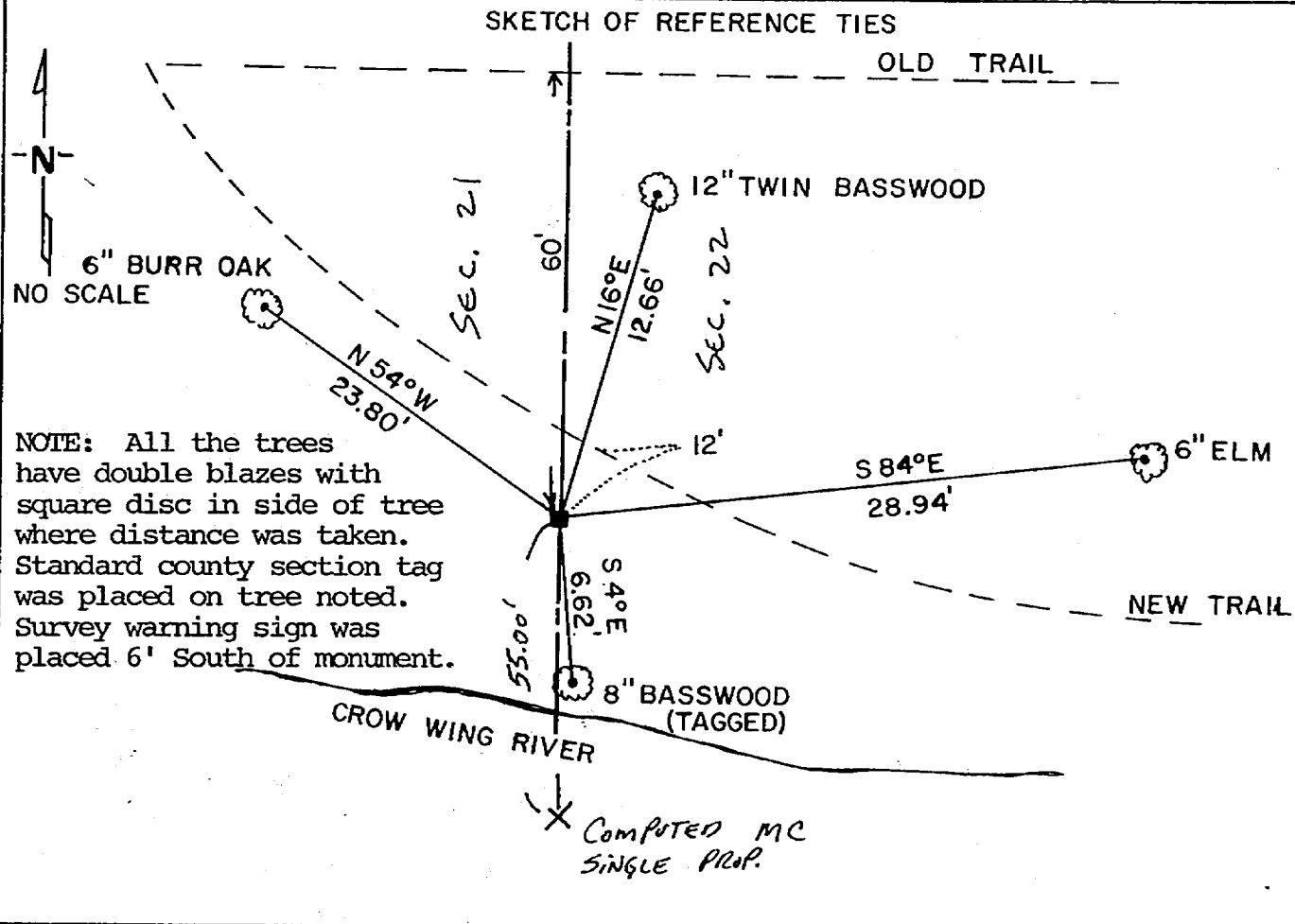

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: MC #10
Section 21, Township 133 North, Range
31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1863 the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1915, E. B. Horst found original Northwest beartree. Set post for WCMC 55 feet North of where corner would fall in river. County Book "C", Page 83.

In 1921, E. B. Horst set iron monument at WCMC location previously established in 1915. Book "D", Page 9.

In 1985 Landecker & Associates, Inc. searched for Horst monument and remains of original Northwest beartree and did not recover. MC #10 was set by single proportionate measure between the Northeast and East quarter of said Section 21. Said position fell in river as noted by Horst. Therefore WCMC was established 55 feet North of corner position on bank of river.
