

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: West quarter corner, Section 23 and
East quarter corner, Section 22, Township 133 North, Range
31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1863, the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1921 E. B. Horst set 1½" x 24" iron monument. County Book "D", Page 9.

In 1964 Dean Anderson, RLS #3091, found iron monument and made ties.

1971 R. F. Schneider, RLS # 5740 , found and used monument.

In 1980 Landecker & Associates, Inc. found monument disturbed and placed a 1" square iron pipe from previous Dean Anderson ties. (Plat of Wheelock Shores)

In 1984 Byron Dahl, RLS #10396 used said monument for survey in said Section 22 (unrecorded Plat of Seista Island).

In 1985 Landecker & Associates, Inc. again found and used said monument intact and replaced as noted on front of sheet.

Landecker & Associates, Inc. accept this monument to be a perpetuation of the original Government Survey.
