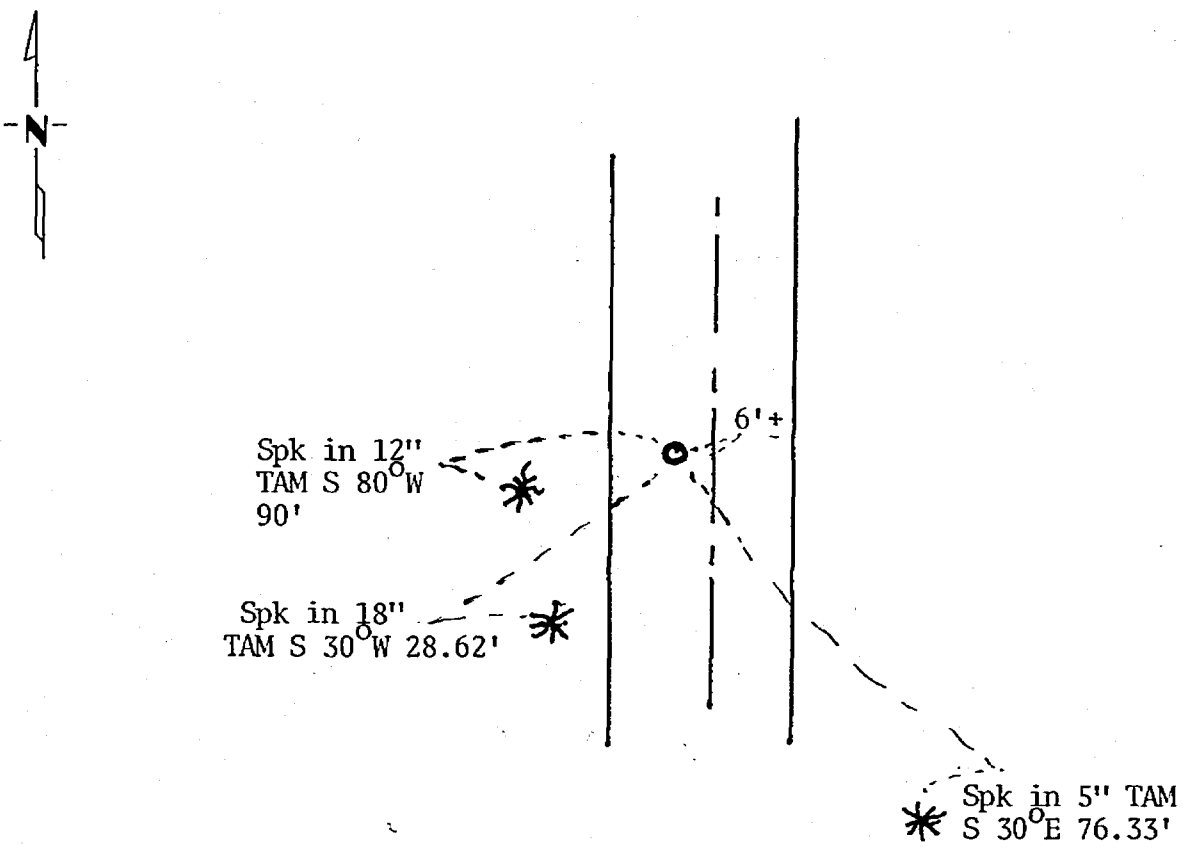

DOCUMENT NO. 295281

Statement of Evidence:

- 1871 - U.S. General Land Office survey (set wood post) for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 3" Tam N  $14^{\circ}$  W 12 links, 5" Tam N  $7^{\circ}$  E 13 links, and 4" Tam S  $34^{\circ}$  E 23 links.
- 1922 - Plat of OAK LAWN BEACH was surveyed by John M. Green. Plat shows this corner as an original government corner and monumented with an iron monument.
- 1937  
1938 - CCC notes at MN/DNR Washburn Lake Forestry station show a found iron pipe buried under road with ties: 5" Bl. Spruce N  $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E 25.4' (1937-24.5') scribed, 6" Bl. Spruce S  $39\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E 35' (1937-34.6') scribed, 6" Bl. Spruce S  $21^{\circ}$  W 39.5' (1937-40') scribed and 6" Spruce on ground N  $69\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W 37' scribed.
- 1979 - Found 1" iron pipe down 0.1' in N-S road. Pipe had been set by Anthony Kerick, RLS over found iron monument. We found partial remains of stumps with scribing visible: S  $25^{\circ}$  W 36' and N  $53^{\circ}$  E 28'.
- 1983 - We revisited corner and found that pipe set by Kerick has been torn out by road grader.
- 1985 - We dug down in road 4' and found top of 2" capped iron monument. This was identified as the type of standard county monument set by Green and other county surveyors in the early 1900's. A county cast iron monument was set over the found pipe and ties taken as shown on this certificate. Corner is 6 feet west of approximate center line of town road and 14 feet north of power line crossing.
