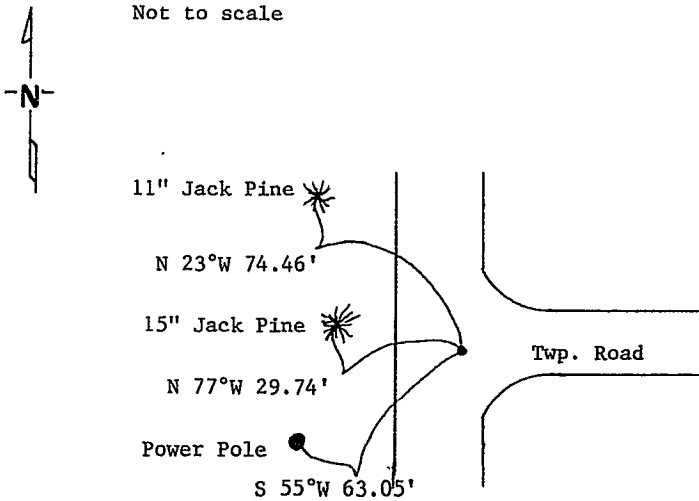

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE North Quarter Corner Section 4, T.134 N., R.32 W., 5th  
P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 10" Sp. Pine N 84°E 104 lks., 10" Sp. Pine S 69°W 126 lks.
- 1985 On August 27, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician, found a 2" I.P. down 1.0' at P.I. of roads N-S-E.
- 1986 On July 29, Terry Freeman and Dan Gordon, left monument as found and marked bearings as shown on front of this certificate.

Although there is not a record of the 2" I.P. being set, the Cass County Surveyors Office feels that the I.P. is a perpetuation of the original corner and accepts it as such.
