This corner was originally established by the U.S. General Land Office survey in 1871. The government notes show corner marked with a wood post with the following bearing trees marked:

6" Birch, S, 77° W., 9 links (5.94 feet)

8" Norway Pine, S. 41° E., 22 links (14.52 feet)
